April 24, 2007, Introduced by Reps. Acciavatti, Byrum, Stahl, Byrnes, Mayes, Rick Jones, Ball, Spade, Meekhof and Bieda and referred to the Committee on Tourism, Outdoor Recreation and Natural Resources.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 76101 (MCL 324.76101), as added by 1995 PA 58.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 76101. As used in this part:
- 2 (a) "Abandoned property" means an aircraft; a watercraft,
- 3 including a ship, boat, canoe, skiff, raft, or barge; the rigging,
- 4 gear, fittings, trappings, and equipment of an aircraft or
- 5 watercraft; the personal property of the officers, crew, and
- 6 passengers of an aircraft or watercraft; and the cargo of an
- 7 aircraft or watercraft, which have been deserted, relinquished,
- 8 cast away, or left behind and for which attempts at reclamation
- 9 have been abandoned by owners and insurers. Abandoned property also
 - means materials resulting from activities of historic and

- 2 (b) "Bottomlands" means the unpatented lake bottomlands of the
- 3 Great Lakes.
- 4 (c) "Committee" means the underwater GREAT LAKES STATE PARK
- 5 AND salvage and preserve ADVISORY committee created in section

- 7 (d) "Great Lakes" means lakes Erie, Huron, Michigan, St.
- 8 Clair, and Superior.
- 9 (e) "Great Lakes bottomlands preserve" means an area located
- 10 on the bottomlands of the Great Lakes and extending upward to and
- 11 including the surface of the water, which is delineated and set
- 12 aside by rule for special protection of abandoned property of
- 13 historical value, or ecological, educational, geological, or scenic
- 14 features or formations having recreational, educational, or
- 15 scientific value. A preserve may encompass a single object,
- 16 feature, or formation, or a collection of several objects,
- 17 features, or formations.
- 18 (f) "Historical value" means value relating to, or
- 19 illustrative of, Michigan history, including the statehood,
- 20 territorial, colonial, and historic, and prehistoric native
- 21 American periods.
- 22 (g) "Mechanical or other assistance" means all humanmade
- 23 devices, including pry bars, wrenches and other hand or power
- 24 tools, cutting torches, explosives, winches, flotation bags, lines
- 25 to surface, extra divers buoyancy devices, and other buoyance
- 26 devices, used to raise or remove artifacts.
- 27 (h) "Recreational value" means value relating to an activity
