

HOUSE BILL No. 4671

April 25, 2007, Introduced by Reps. Jackson, Johnson, Cheeks, Cushingberry, Virgil Smith, Lemmons and Alma Smith and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled
"Michigan vehicle code,"
by amending section 313 (MCL 257.313), as amended by 2004 PA 362.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 313. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) and section
2 812, if an operator's or chauffeur's license issued under this
3 chapter is lost, destroyed, or mutilated, or becomes illegible, the
4 person to whom the license was issued may obtain a duplicate upon
5 the payment of the fee required in section 812, upon furnishing
6 proof satisfactory to the secretary of state that the license has
7 been lost, destroyed, or mutilated, or has become illegible, and
8 upon certifying that the license is not being held by a court as a
9 condition of that person's recognizance. The secretary of state may

1 check the applicant's driving record through the national driver
2 register and the commercial driver license information system
3 before issuing a license under this section.

4 (2) Subsection (1) does not apply if the operator's or
5 chauffeur's license is destroyed pursuant to section 625g(1)(b)(iii).

6 (3) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL NOT ISSUE A REPLACEMENT
7 LICENSE UNDER THIS SECTION UNLESS THE APPLICANT FIRST PROVIDES NOT
8 FEWER THAN 3 SEPARATE PIECES OF IDENTIFICATION ESTABLISHING THAT
9 THE APPLICANT IS THE PERSON HE OR SHE CLAIMS TO BE. THE
10 IDENTIFICATION REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE OF A TYPE AS
11 DETERMINED BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE.
