HOUSE BILL No. 4835

May 24, 2007, Introduced by Reps. Constan, Young, Scott, Polidori, Hammel, Vagnozzi, Clemente, Melton, Clack, Meadows, Coulouris, Espinoza, Lemmons, Donigan and Gaffney and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled

"Revised judicature act of 1961,"

by amending sections 5201 and 5205 (MCL 600.5201 and 600.5205) and by adding section 5202; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 5201. (1) All assignments AN ASSIGNMENT commonly called A

 - (B) THE ASSIGNMENT IS of all the property of the assignor not exempt from execution, and the UNDER SECTION 5202.
 - (C) WITHIN 10 DAYS AFTER THE ASSIGNMENT IS MADE, ALL OF THE

- 1 FOLLOWING ARE FILED WITH THE CLERK OF THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR THE
- 2 COUNTY IN WHICH THE ASSIGNOR RESIDES OR, IF THE ASSIGNOR DOES NOT
- 3 RESIDE IN THIS STATE, FOR THE COUNTY WHERE THE ASSIGNED PROPERTY IS
- 4 PRINCIPALLY LOCATED:
- 5 (i) THE instrument of assignment, (or a duplicate thereof), a

- 9 assignee. are filed in the office of the clerk of the circuit court

- 11 state, then of the county where the assigned property is
- 12 principally located, within 10 days after the making thereof.
- 13 (2) No such AN assignment is effectual to UNDER THIS SECTION
- 14 DOES NOT convey the title to the property to the assignee until
- 15 such A bond AS REQUIRED BY SUBSECTION (1) is filed with and
- 16 approved by said THE clerk.
- 17 (3) No AN attachment or execution levied upon any assigned
- 18 property of such THE assignor after such AN assignment UNDER THIS
- 19 SECTION and before the expiration of the time provided herein for
- 20 filing such A bond UNDER THIS SECTION, is NOT valid, and does not
- 21 create any A lien upon such ON THE property.
- 22 (4) Such AN assignment UNDER THIS SECTION shall be
- 23 acknowledged before some AN officer authorized to take
- 24 acknowledgments. Such AN inventory shall be PREPARED CONTAINING a

- 11 (5) Such THE bond REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (1) shall be to
- 12 the assignor for the joint and several use and benefit of himself
- 13 THE ASSIGNOR and each, any, and all of the creditors of such THE
- 14 assignor in a penal sum at least double the value of the assigned
- 15 property as shown by such THE inventory REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION
- 16 (4), and conditioned for the prompt and faithful administration of
- 17 the trust by the assignee, and shall be signed by the assignee and
- 18 sufficient surety or sureties, who shall, under oath endorsed on

- 20 and above all exemptions, incumbrances, and debts, the penal sum of

- 4 OF THE DEBTOR.
- 5 (E) PROFESSIONALLY PRESCRIBED HEALTH AIDS.
- 6 (F) PROVISIONS AND FUEL FOR COMFORTABLE SUBSISTENCE OF EACH
- 7 HOUSEHOLDER AND HIS OR HER FAMILY FOR 6 MONTHS.
- 8 (G) THE INTEREST, NOT TO EXCEED A VALUE OF \$475.00 IN EACH
- 9 ITEM AND AN AGGREGATE VALUE OF \$3,200.00, IN HOUSEHOLD GOODS,

- 5 THAT THIS EXEMPTION DOES NOT APPLY TO ACTIONS TO RECOVER FOR
- 6 NECESSITIES CONTRACTED FOR AFTER THE ACCRUAL OF THE BENEFITS.
- 7 (O) THE INTEREST, NOT EXCEEDING \$1,075.00 IN PAR VALUE, IN
- 8 SHARES HELD BY A MEMBER, WHO IS A HOUSEHOLDER, OF AN ASSOCIATION
- 9 INCORPORATED UNDER THE SAVINGS AND LOAN ACT OF 1980, 1980 PA 307,
- 10 MCL 491.102 TO 491.1202, EXCEPT THAT THIS EXEMPTION DOES NOT APPLY
- 11 TO A PERSON WHO HAS A HOMESTEAD EXEMPTED UNDER THE GENERAL LAWS OF

- 13 (P) ALL INDIVIDUAL RETIREMENT ACCOUNTS, INCLUDING ROTH IRAS,
- 14 OR INDIVIDUAL RETIREMENT ANNUITIES AS DEFINED IN SECTION 408 OR
- 15 408A OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE, 26 USC 408 AND 408A, AND THE

- 2 TO THE INDIVIDUAL RETIREMENT ACCOUNT OR PREMIUMS ON THE INDIVIDUAL
- 3 RETIREMENT ANNUITY, INCLUDING THE EARNINGS OR BENEFITS FROM THOSE
- 4 CONTRIBUTIONS OR PREMIUMS, THAT, IN THE TAX YEAR MADE OR PAID,

- 10 SECTION 403(B) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE, 26 USC 403.
- 11 (Q) THE RIGHT OR INTEREST OF A PERSON IN A PENSION, PROFIT-
- 12 SHARING, STOCK BONUS, OR OTHER PLAN THAT IS QUALIFIED UNDER SECTION
- 13 401 OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE, 26 USC 401, OR AN ANNUITY
- 14 CONTRACT UNDER SECTION 403(B) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE, 26 USC
- 15 403, IF THE PLAN OR ANNUITY IS SUBJECT TO THE EMPLOYEE RETIREMENT

- 7 (S) PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN SECTION 1 OF 1927 PA 212, MCL
- 8 557.151, OR REAL PROPERTY, HELD JOINTLY BY A HUSBAND AND WIFE AS A
- 9 TENANCY BY THE ENTIRETY, EXCEPT THAT THIS EXEMPTION DOES NOT APPLY
- 10 WITH REGARD TO A CLAIM BASED ON A JOINT DEBT OF THE HUSBAND AND
- 11 WIFE.
- 12 (T) IF THE OWNER OF A HOMESTEAD DIES, LEAVING A SURVIVING
- 13 SPOUSE BUT NO CHILDREN, THE SURVIVING SPOUSE BEFORE HIS OR HER
- 14 REMARRIAGE, UNLESS THE SURVIVING SPOUSE IS THE OWNER OF A HOMESTEAD
- 15 IN HIS OR HER OWN RIGHT, MAY EXEMPT THE HOMESTEAD AND THE RENTS AND

- 17 (B) "DISABLED" MEANS UNABLE TO ENGAGE IN SUBSTANTIAL GAINFUL
- 18 ACTIVITY, AS DEFINED BY 42 USC 1382C(A)(3)(E), AS A RESULT OF A
- 19 PHYSICAL OR MENTAL IMPAIRMENT AND RECEIVING SUPPLEMENTAL SECURITY
- 20 INCOME UNDER 42 USC 1382(A)(3)(A) AND (C).
- 21 (C) "PROCEEDS" MEANS MONEY PAYABLE OR PAID AS A RESULT OF 1 OR
- 22 MORE OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 23 (i) SALE OF THE PROPERTY.
- 24 (ii) INSURANCE OR OTHER INDEMNIFICATION FOR DAMAGE OR
- 25 DESTRUCTION OF THE PROPERTY.
- 26 (iii) COMPENSATION FOR THE ACQUISITION FOR PUBLIC USE OF THE
- 27 PROPERTY.

- 1 (D) "HOMESTEAD" MEANS 1 OF THE FOLLOWING OWNED OR BEING
- 2 PURCHASED UNDER AN EXECUTORY CONTRACT BY THE DEBTOR THAT THE DEBTOR
- 3 OR A DEPENDENT OF THE DEBTOR OCCUPIES AS HIS OR HER PRINCIPAL
- 4 RESIDENCE:
- 5 (i) IF THE LAND IS LOCATED OUTSIDE OF A RECORDED PLAT, CITY, OR
- 6 VILLAGE, A RESIDENTIAL DWELLING AND APPURTENANCES AND THE LAND ON
- 7 WHICH THEY ARE SITUATED, NOT EXCEEDING 40 ACRES.
- 8 (ii) IF THE LAND IS LOCATED WITHIN A RECORDED PLAT, CITY, OR
- 9 VILLAGE, A RESIDENTIAL DWELLING AND APPURTENANCES AND THE LAND ON
- 10 WHICH THEY ARE SITUATED, NOT EXCEEDING 1 LOT OR PARCEL.
- 11 (iii) A RESIDENTIAL DWELLING SITUATED ON LAND NOT OWNED BY THE
- 12 DEBTOR.
- 13 (iv) A CONDOMINIUM UNIT.
- 14 (v) A UNIT IN A COOPERATIVE.
- 15 (vi) A MOTOR HOME.
- 16 (vii) A BOAT OR OTHER WATERCRAFT.
- 17 (E) "RESIDENTIAL DWELLING" INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, A
- 18 HOUSE OR A MANUFACTURED OR MOBILE HOME.
- 19 Sec. 5205. Such AN assignment shall be deemed to convey UNDER
- 20 SECTION 5201 CONVEYS to the assignee all property of the assignor
- 21 not exempt from execution UNDER SECTION 5202, and all rights legal
- 22 or equitable of said THE assignor. The assignee shall also be
- 23 trustee of the estate of the debtor for the benefit of his_THE
- 24 DEBTOR'S creditors and may recover all property or rights or
- 25 equities in property which THAT might be recovered by any creditor.
- 26 When IF more than 1 assignee is appointed, the debts and property
- 27 of the assignor may be collected and received by 1 of them and when

- 1 IF there are more than 2 assignees, every power and authority of
- 2 the whole may be exercised by any 2 of them. The survivor or
- 3 survivors of any assignees shall have AN ASSIGNEE HAVE all their
- 4 THE powers and rights and all OF THE ASSIGNEE. ALL property in the
- 5 hands-POSSESSION of any-THE assignee at the time of his-THE
- 6 ASSIGNEE'S death, removal, or incapacity, shall be delivered to the
- 7 remaining assignee or assignees if there be ARE any, or to the
- 8 successor of the one so dying, ASSIGNEE WHO DIED OR WAS removed or
- 9 incapacitated. , who A SUCCESSOR WHO IS ENTITLED TO POSSESSION OF
- 10 PROPERTY may demand and sue for POSSESSION OF the same PROPERTY.

- 12 of 1961, 1961 PA 236, MCL 600.5451, is repealed.
