A bill to amend 1972 PA 222, entitled

"An act to provide for an official personal identification card; to provide for its form, issuance and use; to regulate the use and disclosure of information obtained from the card; to prescribe the powers and duties of the secretary of state; to prescribe fees; to prescribe certain penalties for violations; and to provide an appropriation for certain purposes,"

(MCL 28.291 to 28.300) by adding section 2a.

- 3 (A) A RADIO FREQUENCY IDENTIFICATION DEVICE.
- 4 (B) ANY OTHER DEVICE CAPABLE OF HAVING STORED INFORMATION READ
- 5 BY A REMOTE RECEIVER, IF THE DEVICE AND REMOTE RECEIVER CAN SHARE
- INFORMATION WHEN THEY DO NOT HAVE A CLEAR LINE OF SIGHT BETWEEN
