THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 16302. (1) A person shall not sell or offer for sale in
- 2 this state containers connected to each other by a separate holding
- 3 device that is constructed of plastic rings unless the device is
- 4 degradable and bears a distinguishing symbol INDICATING THAT IT IS
- 5 DEGRADABLE.
- 6 (2) A PERSON SHALL NOT SELL OR OFFER FOR SALE IN THIS STATE A
- 7 DISPOSABLE CONTAINER FOR LIVE FISHING BAIT UNLESS THE BAIT
- CONTAINER IS DEGRADABLE AND BEARS A DISTINGUISHING SYMBOL
- INDICATING THAT IT IS DEGRADABLE.
