

HOUSE BILL No. 5141

August 29, 2007, Introduced by Reps. Meltzer, Ball, Hoogendyk, Moss, Knollenberg, Calley, Garfield, Stakoe, Nitz, Steil, Pearce, Elsenheimer, Emmons, Huizenga, Wenke, Gaffney, Stahl, Marleau, Sheen and Meekhof and referred to the Committee on Oversight and Investigations.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled
"Michigan election law,"
(MCL 168.1 to 168.992) by adding section 848a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 848A. IF A CANDIDATE HAS NOT FILED OR PAID ALL
2 STATEMENTS, REPORTS, LATE FILING FEES, AND FINES REQUIRED OF THE
3 CANDIDATE OR A CANDIDATE COMMITTEE ORGANIZED TO SUPPORT THE
4 CANDIDATE'S ELECTION UNDER THE MICHIGAN CAMPAIGN FINANCE ACT, 1976
5 PA 388, MCL 169.201 TO 169.282, AND THOSE STATEMENTS, REPORTS, LATE
6 FILING FEES, OR FINES REMAIN UNFILED OR UNPAID FOR MORE THAN 12
7 MONTHS, THAT CANDIDATE IS NOT ELIGIBLE TO RUN FOR ANY PUBLIC OFFICE
8 IN THIS STATE UNTIL THOSE STATEMENTS, REPORTS, LATE FILING FEES, OR
9 FINES HAVE BEEN FILED OR PAID.
