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HOUSE BILL No. 5430

November 8, 2007, Introduced by Rep. Sak and referred to the Committee on Intergovernmental, Urban and Regional Affairs.

A bill to amend 1939 PA 178, entitled

"An act to provide for the collection of water or sewage system rates, assessments, charges, or rentals; and to provide a lien for water or sewage system services furnished by municipalities as defined by this act,"

by amending section 5 (MCL 123.165), as amended by 1981 PA 132.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:
