## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1107. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Department" means the Michigan department of agriculture.
- 3 (b) "Director" means the director of the Michigan department
- 4 of agriculture or his or her designee.
- 5 (c) "Extended retail food establishment" means a retail
- 6 grocery that does both of the following:

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- (i) Serves or provides an unpackaged food for immediate consumption.
  - (ii) Provides customer seating in the food service area.
- (d) "Federal act" means the federal food, drug, and cosmetic act, chapter 675, 52 Stat. 1040. , 21 U.S.C. 301 to 321, 331 to

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- 1 333, 334 to 343-3, 344 to 346a, 347, 348 to 356c, 358 to 360, 360b
- 2 to 360dd, 360hh to 363, 371 to 376, and 378 to 397.
- 3 (e) "Food" means articles used for food or drink for humans or
- 4 other animals, chewing gum, and articles used for components of any
- 5 such article.
- 6 (f) "Food additive" means any substance, the intended use of
- 7 which, directly or indirectly, results in or may be reasonably
- 8 expected to result in its becoming a component or otherwise
- 9 affecting the characteristics of any food if that substance is not

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- 2 (k) "Food service establishment" means a fixed or mobile

- 4 grill, tearoom, sandwich shop, soda fountain, tavern, bar, cocktail
- 5 lounge, nightclub, drive-in, industrial feeding establishment,
- 6 private organization serving the public, rental hall, catering
- 7 kitchen, delicatessen, theater, commissary, or similar place in
- 8 which food or drink is prepared for direct consumption through
- 9 service on the premises or elsewhere, and any other eating or
- 10 drinking establishment or operation where food is served or
