## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 4. The following provisions shall apply with respect to

  THE public notice of meetings:
- (a) A public notice shall always contain the name of the
  public body to which the notice applies, its telephone number if
  one exists, and its address.
  - (b) A public notice for a public body shall always be posted at its principal office and any other locations considered appropriate by the public body. Cable television may also be utilized for purposes of posting public notice.

- 1 (c) If a public body is a part of a state department, part of
- 2 the legislative or judicial branch of state government, part of an

- 4 or school district, a public notice shall also be posted in the
