HOUSE BILL No. 6155

May 22, 2008, Introduced by Rep. Sak and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1972 PA 230, entitled "Stille-DeRossett-Hale single state construction code act," (MCL 125.1501 to 125.1531) by adding section 4d.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 4D. (1) BEGINNING 1 YEAR AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE
- 2 RULES PROMULGATED UNDER SUBSECTION (2), THE OWNER OR OPERATOR OF
- 3 RESIDENTIAL OCCUPANCIES WHERE THE OCCUPANTS ARE PRIMARILY TRANSIENT
- 4 IN NATURE, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, BOARDING HOUSES, HOTELS,
- 5 AND MOTELS, SHALL INSTALL 1 OR MORE CARBON MONOXIDE ALARMS IN EACH
- DWELLING UNIT OR SLEEPING ROOM, AS PROVIDED IN THOSE RULES.
- 7 (2) THE DIRECTOR SHALL PROMULGATE RULES THAT ESTABLISH
- 8 STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS FOR THE INSTALLATION OF CARBON MONOXIDE
 - ALARMS AS REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (1). HOWEVER, THOSE RULES SHALL

- 1 NOT REQUIRE HARD-WIRED CARBON MONOXIDE ALARMS IN ALL ROOMS AND

- 19 (5) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "CARBON MONOXIDE ALARM" MEANS A
- 20 DEVICE DESIGNED TO RESPOND TO THE PRESENCE OF CARBON MONOXIDE AND
- 21 PROVIDE AN ALARM SUITABLE TO ALERT THE OCCUPANTS OF CARBON MONOXIDE
- 22 LEVELS BELOW THOSE THAT CAUSE A LOSS OF ABILITY TO REACT TO THE
- 23 DANGERS OF CARBON MONOXIDE EXPOSURE.
