

HOUSE BILL No. 6229

June 10, 2008, Introduced by Rep. Calley and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled
"Revised judicature act of 1961,"
(MCL 600.101 to 600.9947) by adding section 2977.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 2977. IF AN ELECTED OFFICIAL OF A COUNTY HAS BEEN
2 CONVICTED OF A CRIMINAL ACT AND IF THE CRIMINAL ACT HAS CAUSED THE
3 COUNTY TO SUSTAIN A PECUNIARY LOSS BECAUSE OF A CIVIL JUDGMENT OR
4 SETTLEMENT OF A CIVIL ACTION, THE COUNTY MAY BRING A CIVIL ACTION
5 AGAINST THE ELECTED OFFICIAL TO RECOVER THE LOSS SUSTAINED BY THE
6 COUNTY.
