A bill to amend 1943 PA 240, entitled "State employees' retirement act,"

(MCL 38.1 to 38.69) by adding section 19k.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 19K. (1) NOTWITHSTANDING SECTION 19, A MEMBER MAY RETIRE
- 2 AND RECEIVE A RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE COMPUTED UNDER THIS SECTION IF
- 3 THE MEMBER MEETS ALL OF THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:
- 4 (A) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2008, OR ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE
- 5 OF HIS OR HER RETIREMENT, WHICHEVER IS EARLIER, THE MEMBER'S
- 6 COMBINED AGE AND LENGTH OF CREDITED SERVICE IS EQUAL TO OR GREATER
 - THAN 80 YEARS.
- 8 (B) THE MEMBER IS AN INDIVIDUAL EMPLOYED BY THE WAYNE COUNTY
- 9 JUDICIAL COUNCIL, IF CREATED, BY THE DETROIT JUDICIAL COUNCIL, IF
- 10 CREATED, OR BY THE CITY OF DETROIT OR WAYNE COUNTY PERFORMING

- 24 ACCOUNT OF ACCUMULATED SICK LEAVE SHALL BE PAID IN 60 CONSECUTIVE
- 25 EQUAL MONTHLY INSTALLMENTS BEGINNING ON OR AFTER NOVEMBER 1, 2009.
- 26 PAYMENTS RECEIVED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL NOT BE USED TO
- 27 PURCHASE SERVICE CREDIT UNDER THIS ACT. THESE PAYMENTS FOR

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- 1 ACCUMULATED SICK LEAVE ARE TO BE PAID FROM FUNDS APPROPRIATED TO

- 9 (3) ANY AMOUNT THAT A MEMBER RETIRING UNDER THIS SECTION IS
- 10 ENTITLED TO RECEIVE IN A LUMP SUM AT RETIREMENT ON ACCOUNT OF
- 11 ACCUMULATED ANNUAL LEAVE SHALL BE PAID ON OR AFTER NOVEMBER 1,
- 12 2008. THESE PAYMENTS ARE NOT PENSIONS, ANNUITIES, RETIREMENT

- 22 OF YEARS AND FRACTION OF A YEAR OF CREDITED SERVICE MULTIPLIED BY
- 23 1-3/4% OF HIS OR HER FINAL AVERAGE COMPENSATION. EXCEPT FOR THE

- 25 ALLOWANCE IS SUBJECT TO SECTION 20. THE MEMBER'S RETIREMENT

- 10 (6) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, AN INDIVIDUAL WHO ELECTED TO
- 11 TERMINATE MEMBERSHIP UNDER SECTION 50 AND WHO, BUT FOR THAT
- 12 ELECTION, WOULD OTHERWISE BE ELIGIBLE FOR MEMBERSHIP IN TIER 1
- 13 UNDER SECTION 13, SHALL BE CONSIDERED A MEMBER OF TIER 1 FOR THE
- 14 LIMITED PURPOSE OF RECEIVING A RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE CALCULATED
- 15 UNDER THIS SECTION AND PAID BY THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM.
