

HOUSE BILL No. 6424

September 10, 2008, Introduced by Reps. Proos, Caul, Acciavatti, Nitz, Opsommer, Hansen, Booher, Emmons, Pavlov, Robertson, Stahl and Dean and referred to the Committee on Tourism, Outdoor Recreation and Natural Resources.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 40114 (MCL 324.40114), as amended by 2004 PA 587.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 40114. (1) The department may issue a permit to a person
2 who is unable to walk because the person is a paraplegic or an
3 amputee or because of a disease or injury that has rendered the
4 person permanently disabled. A permit issued under this subsection
5 authorizes the person to take game during the open season for that
6 game, including deer of either sex, from or upon a standing vehicle
7 if that person holds a license to take that game issued pursuant to

1 part 435 and complies with all other laws and rules for the taking
2 of game.

3 (2) The department may issue a permit to a person who is
4 permanently disabled, ~~and who~~ has full use of only 1 arm, and, ~~who~~
5 upon investigation, is unable to hold, aim, and shoot a bow. A
6 permit issued under this subsection authorizes the person to take
7 game during the open season for that game with a bow that has been
8 modified so that the bow may be held, aimed, and shot with 1 arm,
9 if that person holds a license to take that game issued pursuant to
10 part 435 and complies with all other laws and rules for the taking
11 of game.

12 (3) In addition, the department may issue permits authorizing
13 1 or more of the following:

14 (a) The taking or possession of animals for the purpose of
15 rehabilitating animals.

16 (b) The taking of animals to prevent or control damage and
17 nuisance caused by the animals. **A PERMITTEE UNDER A DEER DAMAGE
18 SHOOTING PERMIT MAY DESIGNATE NOT MORE THAN 15 AUTHORIZED SHOOTERS
19 TO IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THE PERMIT.**

20 (c) The collection, transportation, possession, or disposition
21 of animals and parts of animals for scientific purposes.

22 (d) The public exhibition of animals.

23 (e) Taxidermy.

24 (f) The disposition of accidentally or unlawfully taken or
25 injured animals or animals that are unlawfully possessed.

26 (g) The taking of game with a crossbow by a person who is
27 permanently disabled.

1 (4) A permit issued under this section may be suspended,
2 revoked, annulled, withdrawn, recalled, canceled, or amended
3 pursuant to the administrative procedures act of 1969, 1969 PA 306,
4 MCL 24.201 to 24.328. If the holder of a permit is convicted of
5 violating this section, his or her permit or license may be revoked
6 and any animal and the parts of any animal in his or her possession
7 shall be disposed of in a manner approved by the department.

8 (5) Fees received for permits and licenses issued under this
9 section shall be forwarded by the department to the state treasurer
10 to be credited to the game and fish protection account of the
11 Michigan conservation and recreation legacy fund provided for in
12 section 2010.
