## **HOUSE BILL No. 6440**

September 11, 2008, Introduced by Rep. Bieda and referred to the Committee on Great Lakes and Environment.

A bill to amend 1976 IL 1, entitled

"A petition to initiate legislation to provide for the use of returnable containers for soft drinks, soda water, carbonated natural or mineral water, other nonalcoholic carbonated drink, and for beer, ale, or other malt drink of whatever alcoholic content, and for certain other beverage containers; to provide for the use of unredeemed bottle deposits; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies and officials; and to prescribe penalties and provide remedies,"

by amending section 3e (MCL 445.573e), as added by 1996 PA 384.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 3e. (1) The cleanup and redevelopment trust fund is
  created within the state treasury.
  - (2) The state treasurer may receive money or other assets from any source for deposit into the trust fund. The state treasurer shall direct the investment of the trust fund. The state treasurer

- 1 shall credit to the trust fund interest and earnings from TRUST
- 2 fund investments.
- 3 (3) Money in the trust fund at the close of the fiscal year
- 4 shall remain in the trust fund and shall not lapse to the general

- 18 redevelopment fund CREATED IN SECTION 20108 OF THE NATURAL
- 19 RESOURCES AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT, 1994 PA 451, MCL
- 20 324.20108, and 10% to the community pollution prevention fund
- 21 created in section 3f.
- 22 (C) FOR THE STATE FISCAL YEARS 2008-2009 AND 2009-2010, A
- 23 CUMULATIVE TOTAL OF \$2,000,000.00 FOR GRANTS FOR RETROFITTING
- 24 REVERSE VENDING MACHINES THAT DEALERS USE TO PROCESS RETURNABLE
- 25 CONTAINERS TO ENABLE THE MACHINES TO REJECT BEVERAGE CONTAINERS
- 26 THAT WERE NOT SOLD IN THIS STATE.
- 27 (5) All money in the trust fund that is not disbursed pursuant

- 1 to subsection (4) shall remain in the trust fund until the trust
