

HOUSE BILL No. 6497

September 24, 2008, Introduced by Rep. Opsommer and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to prohibit this state from entering into certain compacts or other agreements.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. As used in this act, "radio frequency identification
2 device" means an electronic device that stores information and is
3 designed to transmit that information by means of radio waves to a
4 receiver.

5 Sec. 2. This state shall not enter into or participate in the
6 interstate compact regarding sharing of driver license data known
7 as the "driver license agreement".

8 Sec. 3. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), this state
9 shall not enter into any compact, memorandum of understanding, or
10 other agreement that would require this state to do any of the
11 following with any information obtained by the state from

1 applicants for, or holders of, operator's or chauffeur's licenses
2 issued under the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.1 to
3 257.923, or applicants for, or holders of, any other noncommercial
4 license that authorizes an individual to operate a motor vehicle in
5 this state:

6 (a) Transmit that information to another state, a foreign
7 country, or an intergovernmental or international organization.

8 (b) Transmit that information to a nongovernmental third party
9 entity that is allowed to share that information with another
10 state, a foreign country, or an intergovernmental or international
11 organization.

12 (c) Allow another state, a foreign country, an
13 intergovernmental or international organization, or a
14 nongovernmental third party entity described in subdivision (b) to
15 access that information or any database containing that
16 information.

17 (2) Subsection (1) does not prohibit an officer or agency of
18 this state from providing pertinent information contained in a
19 database maintained by this state in connection with specific
20 individual criminal investigations being conducted by a law
21 enforcement agency of a foreign country in conjunction with the
22 international criminal police organization or other federally
23 authorized foreign entity.

24 Sec. 4. This state shall not enter into any compact,
25 memorandum of understanding, or other agreement that would require
26 this state to do any of the following in connection with the
27 application for, or issuance of, an operator's or chauffeur's

1 license issued under the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL
2 257.1 to 257.923, or applicants for, or holders of, any other
3 noncommercial license that authorizes an individual to operate a
4 motor vehicle in this state:

5 (a) Obtain an individual's fingerprints or palm prints, or
6 photographic or digital images of fingerprints or palm prints.

7 (b) Obtain digital images of an individual's iris or retina.

8 (c) Determine whether an individual owns a firearm or is
9 licensed to carry a concealed pistol, or indicate that status on
10 the license.

11 (d) Issue a license that contains either of the following:

12 (i) A radio frequency identification device.

13 (ii) Any other device capable of having stored information read
14 by a remote receiver, if the device and remote receiver can share
15 information when they do not have a clear line of sight between
16 them.
