September 24, 2008, Introduced by Rep. Alma Smith and referred to the Committee on New Economy and Quality of Life.

A bill to amend 1996 PA 376, entitled

"Michigan renaissance zone act,"

by amending section 3 (MCL 125.2683), as amended by 2008 PA 217.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3. As used in this act:
- 2 (A) "AEROTROPOLIS DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION" MEANS A PUBLIC
- 3 BOARD, COMMISSION, OR COUNCIL FORMED BY 2 OR MORE LOCAL
- 4 GOVERNMENTAL UNITS UNDER SECTION 8G.
- 5 (B) "AEROTROPOLIS DEVELOPMENT ZONE" MEANS A RENAISSANCE ZONE
- 6 CREATED UNDER SECTION 8G.
 - (C) (a) "Agricultural processing facility" means 1 or more
 - facilities or operations that transform, package, sort, or grade
 - livestock or livestock products, agricultural commodities, or
- 10 plants or plant products, excluding forest products, into goods
 - that are used for intermediate or final consumption including goods

- 1 for nonfood use, and surrounding property.
- 2 (D) (b)—"Board" means the state administrative board created
- 3 in 1921 PA 2, MCL 17.1 to 17.3.
- 4 (E) (c) "Development plan" means a written plan that addresses
- 5 the criteria in section 7 and includes all of the following:
- 6 (i) A map of the proposed renaissance zone that indicates the
- 7 geographic boundaries, the total area, and the present use and
- 8 conditions generally of the land and structures within those
- 9 boundaries.
- 10 (ii) Evidence of community support and commitment from
- 11 residential and business interests.
- 12 (iii) A description of the methods proposed to increase economic
- 13 opportunity and expansion, facilitate infrastructure improvement,
- 14 and identify job training opportunities.
- 15 (iv) Current social, economic, and demographic characteristics
- 16 of the proposed renaissance zone and anticipated improvements in
- 17 education, health, human services, public safety, and employment if
- 18 the renaissance zone is created.
- (v) Any other information required by the board.
- 20 (F) (d) "Elected county executive" means the elected county
- 21 executive in a county organized under 1966 PA 293, MCL 45.501 to
- 22 45.521, or 1973 PA 139, MCL 45.551 to 45.573.
- 23 (G) (e) "Forest products processing facility" means 1 or more
- 24 facilities or operations that transform, package, sort, recycle, or
- 25 grade forest or paper products into goods that are used for
- 26 intermediate or final use or consumption or for the creation of
- 27 biomass or alternative fuels through the utilization of forest

- 1 products or forest residue, and surrounding property. Forest
- 2 products processing facility does not include an existing facility
- 3 or operation that is located in this state that relocates to a
- 4 renaissance zone for a forest products processing facility. Forest
- 5 products processing facility does not include a facility or
- 6 operation that engages primarily in retail sales.
- 7 (H) (f) "Local governmental unit" means a county, city,
- 8 village, or township.
- 9 (I) (g) "Person" means an individual, partnership,
- 10 corporation, association, limited liability company, governmental
- 11 entity, or other legal entity.
- 12 (J) "QUALIFIED AEROTROPOLIS BUSINESS" MEANS AN AIR-COMMERCE
- 13 LINKED BUSINESS, SUPPLY CHAIN BUSINESS, OR A BUSINESS NEEDING TO BE
- 14 PHYSICALLY LOCATED NEAR AN AIRPORT FOR BUSINESS PURPOSES, THAT HAS
- 15 BEEN APPROVED BY THE AEROTROPOLIS DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION AND HAS
- 16 BEEN CERTIFIED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE MICHIGAN STRATEGIC FUND. A
- 17 SUPPLY CHAIN BUSINESS INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, A BUSINESS
- 18 THAT PROVIDES VALUE TO CUSTOMERS THROUGH APPLYING AN INTEGRATED
- 19 APPROACH TO PLANNING, IMPLEMENTING, AND CONTROLLING THE FLOW OF
- 20 INFORMATION, MATERIALS, AND SERVICES FROM INITIATION OF PRODUCT
- 21 CONCEPT AND DEVELOPMENT THROUGH AND INCLUDING THE DISTRIBUTION OF
- 22 THE FINISHED PRODUCT TO THE END CUSTOMER, INCLUDING, BUT NOT
- 23 LIMITED TO, PROCUREMENT, MANUFACTURING, TECHNOLOGY, DISTRIBUTION,
- 24 WAREHOUSING, MARKETING, LOGISTICS, TRANSPORTATION, OR RELATED
- 25 VALUE-ADDED PROCESSES AND ACTIVITIES, INCLUDING RELATED CORPORATE
- 26 OFFICES. A QUALIFIED AEROTROPOLIS BUSINESS DOES NOT INCLUDE A
- 27 CASINO, RETAIL ESTABLISHMENT, PROFESSIONAL SPORTS STADIUM, OR THAT

- 1 PORTION OF A QUALIFIED AEROTROPOLIS BUSINESS USED EXCLUSIVELY FOR
- 2 RETAIL SALES. AS USED IN THIS SUBDIVISION, "CASINO" MEANS A CASINO
- 3 REGULATED BY THIS STATE PURSUANT TO THE MICHIGAN GAMING CONTROL AND
- 4 REVENUE ACT, 1996 IL 1, MCL 432.201 TO 432.226, AND ALL PROPERTY
- 5 ASSOCIATED OR AFFILIATED WITH THE OPERATION OF A CASINO, INCLUDING,
- 6 BUT NOT LIMITED TO, A PARKING LOT, HOTEL, MOTEL, OR RETAIL STORE.
- 7 (K) (h)—"Qualified local governmental unit" means either of
- 8 the following:
- 9 (i) A county.
- 10 (ii) A city, village, or township that contains an eligible
- 11 distressed area as defined in section 11 of the state housing
- 12 development authority act of 1966, 1966 PA 346, MCL 125.1411.
- 13 (1) $\frac{(i)}{(i)}$ "Recovery zone" means a tool and die renaissance
- 14 recovery zone created in section 8d.
- 15 (M) (j) "Renaissance zone" means a geographic area designated
- 16 under this act.
- 17 (N) (k) "Renewable energy facility" means a facility that
- 18 creates energy directly or fuel from the wind, the sun, trees,
- 19 grasses, biosolids, algae, agricultural commodities, processed
- 20 products from agricultural commodities, or residues from
- 21 agricultural processes, wood or forest processes, food production
- 22 and processing, or the paper products industry. Renewable energy
- 23 facility also includes a facility that creates energy or fuels from
- 24 solid biomass, animal wastes, or landfill gases. Renewable energy
- 25 facility also includes a facility that focuses on research,
- 26 development, or manufacturing of systems or components of systems
- 27 used to create energy or fuel from the items described in this

- 3 defined in section 7ff of the general property tax act, 1893 PA
- 4 206, MCL 211.7ff.
- 5 (P) (m) "Review board" means the renaissance zone review board
- 6 created in section 5.
- 7 (Q) $\frac{(n)}{(n)}$ "Rural area" means an area that lies outside of the
- 8 boundaries of an urban area.
- 9 (R) (O) "Urban area" means an urbanized area as determined by
- 10 the economics and statistics administration, United States bureau
- 11 of the census according to the 1990 census.
