

# HOUSE BILL No. 6552

October 15, 2008, Introduced by Rep. Opsommer and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to prohibit this state from entering into certain compacts or other agreements.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           Sec. 1. As used in this act, "radio frequency identification  
2 device" means an electronic device that stores information and is  
3 designed to transmit that information by means of radio waves to a  
4 receiver.

5           Sec. 2. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), this state  
6 shall not enter into any compact, memorandum of understanding, or  
7 other agreement that would require this state to do any of the  
8 following with any information obtained by the state from  
9 applicants for, or holders of, an official state personal  
10 identification card issued under 1972 PA 222, MCL 28.291 to 28.300:

11           (a) Transmit that information to another state, a foreign

1 country, or an intergovernmental or international organization.

2 (b) Transmit that information to a nongovernmental third party  
3 entity that is allowed to share that information with another  
4 state, a foreign country, or an intergovernmental or international  
5 organization.

6 (c) Allow another state, a foreign country, an  
7 intergovernmental or international organization, or a  
8 nongovernmental third party entity described in subdivision (b) to  
9 access that information or any database containing that  
10 information.

11 (2) Subsection (1) does not prohibit an officer or agency of  
12 this state from providing pertinent information contained in a  
13 database maintained by this state in connection with specific  
14 individual criminal investigations being conducted by a law  
15 enforcement agency of a foreign country in conjunction with the  
16 international criminal police organization or other federally  
17 authorized foreign entity.

18 Sec. 3. This state shall not enter into any compact,  
19 memorandum of understanding, or other agreement that would require  
20 this state to do any of the following in connection with the  
21 application for, or issuance of, an official state personal  
22 identification card issued under 1972 PA 222, MCL 28.291 to 28.300:

23 (a) Obtain an individual's fingerprints or palm prints, or  
24 photographic or digital images of fingerprints or palm prints.

25 (b) Obtain digital images of an individual's iris or retina.

26 (c) Determine whether an individual owns a firearm or is  
27 licensed to carry a concealed pistol, or indicate that status on

1 the identification card.

2 (d) Issue an identification card that contains either of the  
3 following:

4 (i) A radio frequency identification device.

5 (ii) Any other device capable of having stored information read  
6 by a remote receiver, if the device and remote receiver can share  
7 information when they do not have a clear line of sight between  
8 them.
