HOUSE BILL No. 6679

November 19, 2008, Introduced by Rep. Alma Smith and referred to the Committee on Tax Policy.

A bill to amend 2000 PA 489, entitled

"Michigan trust fund act,"

by amending sections 9 and 10 (MCL 12.259 and 12.260), as added by 2005 PA 232; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 9. (1) The Michigan merit award trust fund is established
- 2 in the department of treasury. The Michigan merit award trust fund
- 3 shall consist only of interest and earnings from Michigan merit
- 4 award trust fund investments, donations of money made to the trust
- 5 fund from any source, and any money allocated as provided by law.
- (2) Money in the Michigan merit award trust fund at the close
 - of a fiscal year shall remain in the Michigan merit award trust
 - fund and shall not revert to the general fund.

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- 1 (3) The state treasurer shall direct the investment of the
- 2 Michigan merit award trust fund.
- 3 (4) Except as otherwise provided in section 7(5), each fiscal
- 4 year, tobacco settlement revenue received by this state BEFORE
- 5 AUGUST 1, 2007 that is not considered a TSR as that term is defined
- 6 under the Michigan tobacco settlement finance authority act, shall
- 7 be-2005 PA 226, MCL 129.261 TO 129.279, IS allocated to the
- 8 Michigan merit award trust fund.
- 9 (5) ON SEPTEMBER 30, 2007, MONEY IN THE MICHIGAN MERIT AWARD
- 10 TRUST FUND OR OTHER MONEY HELD BY THE STATE TREASURER FOR PURPOSES
- 11 OF THIS SECTION OR SECTION 10 SHALL REVERT TO THE GENERAL FUND.
- Sec. 10. (1) Upon appropriation, the state treasurer shall
- 13 disburse funds from the Michigan merit award trust fund for 1 or
- 14 more of the following purposes:
- 15 (a) Michigan merit award scholarships under the Michigan merit
- 16 award scholarship act, 1999 PA 94, MCL 390.1451 to 390.1459, or to
- 17 a successor to that program.
- 18 (b) Expenses properly incurred in the administration of the
- 19 Michigan merit award scholarships and the test by which awardees of
- 20 the Michigan merit award scholarships are determined.
- 21 (c) Funding of the tuition incentive program as described in
- 22 section 310 of 1998 PA 271 or a successor to that program.
- 23 (d) Funding of the Michigan nursing scholarship program as
- 24 described in the Michigan nursing scholarship act, 2002 PA 591, MCL
- 25 390.1181 to 390.1189.
- 26 (e) Other expenditures as determined by law.
- 27 (2) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL NOT DISBURSE FUNDS FROM THE

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- 1 MICHIGAN MERIT AWARD TRUST FUND UNDER THIS SECTION IN THE 2007-2008
- 2 ACADEMIC YEAR OR ANY SUBSEQUENT ACADEMIC YEAR.
- 3 (3) IF THE STATE TREASURER INCURS AN OBLIGATION TO DISBURSE
- 4 FUNDS FROM THE MICHIGAN MERIT AWARD TRUST FUND UNDER THIS SECTION
- 5 BEFORE THE 2007-2008 ACADEMIC YEAR, AND THAT OBLIGATION OR ANY PART
- 6 OF THE OBLIGATION IS UNPAID AS OF SEPTEMBER 15, 2007, THE
- 7 OBLIGATION OR REMAINING PART OF THE OBLIGATION IS VOID AND
- 8 UNENFORCEABLE AND THE STATE TREASURER SHALL NOT DISBURSE FUNDS FOR
- 9 THAT UNPAID AMOUNT.
- 10 (4) BEGINNING ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT
- 11 ADDED THIS SUBSECTION, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL NOTIFY EACH PERSON
- 12 TO WHICH THE STATE TREASURER OWES AN OBLIGATION OF ANY PART OF AN
- 13 OBLIGATION, OR TO WHICH THE STATE TREASURER INCURS AN OBLIGATION,
- 14 TO DISBURSE FUNDS FROM THE MICHIGAN MERIT AWARD TRUST FUND UNDER
- 15 THIS SECTION OF THE PENDING REPEAL OF THIS SECTION AND SECTION 9
- 16 AND THE TIMETABLES DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTIONS (2) AND (3).
- 17 (5) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "ACADEMIC YEAR" MEANS THE PERIOD
- 18 FROM AUGUST 1 OF A CALENDAR YEAR TO JULY 31 OF THE NEXT CALENDAR
- 19 YEAR.
- 20 Enacting section 1. Sections 9 and 10 of the Michigan trust
- 21 fund act, 2000 PA 489, MCL 12.259 and 12.260, are repealed
- 22 effective October 1, 2007.
- 23 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 24 unless Senate Bill No. or House Bill No. 6680 (request no.
- 25 01102'07) of the 94th Legislature is enacted into law.
