

SENATE BILL No. 4

January 10, 2007, Introduced by Senator HARDIMAN and referred to the Committee on Homeland Security and Emerging Technologies.

A bill to amend 1991 PA 179, entitled
"Michigan telecommunications act,"
(MCL 484.2101 to 484.2604) by adding section 360a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 360A. (1) A PROVIDER OF CELLULAR OR MOBILE
2 TELECOMMUNICATION SERVICE SHALL NOT PROVIDE, SELL, OR INCLUDE THE
3 DIALING NUMBER OF A CUSTOMER FOR INCLUSION WITH ANY DIRECTORY
4 ASSISTANCE WITHOUT FIRST OBTAINING THE WRITTEN OR ELECTRONIC
5 CONSENT OF THE CUSTOMER. A CUSTOMER MAY REVOKE THAT CONSENT AT ANY
6 TIME. A PROVIDER OF CELLULAR OR MOBILE TELECOMMUNICATION SERVICE
7 SHALL REMOVE THE LISTING OF SUCH A CUSTOMER FROM DIRECTORY
8 ASSISTANCE AND NOT INCLUDE IT IN FUTURE PUBLICATIONS OR

1 COMMUNICATIONS OF THE DIRECTORY. A CELLULAR OR MOBILE
2 TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICE CUSTOMER SHALL NOT BE CHARGED FOR MAKING
3 THE CHOICE TO NOT BE INCLUDED WITH ANY DIRECTORY ASSISTANCE.

4 (2) THE WRITTEN CONSENT REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (1) SHALL BE
5 ON A SEPARATE DOCUMENT PROVIDED FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF OBTAINING
6 THE CUSTOMER'S CONSENT.
