THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 37A. (1) BEFORE A PRISONER IS RELEASED ON PAROLE OR
- 2 DISCHARGED WITHOUT BEING PAROLED, THE PRISONER SHALL UNDERGO A TEST
- 3 FOR HIV OR AN ANTIBODY TO HIV, AND A TEST TO DETERMINE IF THE
- 4 PRISONER IS INFECTED WITH HEPATITIS C. THE TESTS SHALL OCCUR NOT
- EARLIER THAN 60 DAYS BEFORE THE PRISONER IS PAROLED OR DISCHARGED.
- (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REPORT EACH POSITIVE TEST RESULT FOR
- HIV OR AN ANTIBODY TO HIV TO THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY HEALTH, IN
- 3 COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 5114 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH CODE, 1978 PA
- 9 368, MCL 333.5114. AS USED IN THIS SUBSECTION, "HIV" AND "POSITIVE
