

SENATE BILL No. 74

January 25, 2007, Introduced by Senators JACOBS, BRATER, PRUSI, HUNTER and JELINEK and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to require police vehicles to be equipped with automatic external defibrillators.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. As used in this act, "police vehicle" means a vehicle
2 clearly marked as being a police vehicle and used by a police
3 department of a city, village, or township, a county sheriff, the
4 department of state police, a Michigan tribal police force, or a
5 public safety department of a community college, college, or
6 university whose officers are authorized by the governing board of
7 that institution to enforce state law and the ordinances of that
8 community college, college, or university, in the performance of
9 law enforcement duties.

10 Sec. 2. Each police vehicle shall be equipped with an

1 automatic external defibrillator.
