THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 33. (1) A security alarm system may not be installed or operated in this state unless the security alarm system is either installed by a security alarm system contractor licensed under this act or is installed by the owner or occupant of a residence in his or her residence.
