- 1 SCHOOL YEAR THEREAFTER, THE BOARD OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT OR BOARD OF
- 2 DIRECTORS OF A PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY THAT OPERATES SOME OR ALL OF
- 3 GRADES K-3 SHALL ENSURE THAT THE AVERAGE CLASS SIZE IN GRADES K-3
- 4 IS NOT MORE THAN 17 PUPILS PER CLASS, WITH NOT MORE THAN 19 PUPILS
- 5 IN ANY PARTICULAR CLASS.
- 6 (6) FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, FREE LUNCH ELIGIBILITY
