

SENATE BILL No. 161

February 6, 2007, Introduced by Senators CLARK-COLEMAN, CHERRY, JACOBS, CLARKE, GLEASON, SCOTT, SCHAUER, HUNTER, BARCIA, ANDERSON, OLSHOVE, BRATER, SWITALSKI and BASHAM and referred to the Committee on Economic Development and Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1956 PA 218, entitled
"The insurance code of 1956,"
(MCL 500.100 to 500.8302) by adding section 2107a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 2107A. AT THE TIME OF APPLICATION, AN AUTOMOBILE INSURER
2 SHALL PROVIDE WRITTEN NOTIFICATION TO EACH APPLICANT FOR AUTOMOBILE
3 INSURANCE OF THE CAUSES THAT WOULD LEAD TO CANCELLATION OR
4 INELIGIBILITY FOR COVERAGE AT THE TIME OF RENEWAL FOR THE
5 AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE POLICY.
