  taken at times and in a manner as provided in this part AND PARTS

  435 AND 473.
  - (2) IN FURTHERANCE OF SECTION 52 OF ARTICLE IV OF THE STATE

    CONSTITUTION OF 1963, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROTECT AND PROMOTE THE

    PEOPLE'S RIGHT TO LAWFULLY FISH AND HARVEST FISH THAT ARE THE
