## **SENATE BILL No. 472**

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 473. (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (4),

  a person shall not use a tobacco product on school property OR IN A

  COLLEGE DORMITORY.
  - (2) A person who violates subsection (1) is guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of not more than \$50.00 \$100.00.
    - (3) As used in this section:
    - (A) "COLLEGE DORMITORY" MEANS A DORMITORY OPERATED BY A DEGREE
