A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 365a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 365A. (1) A PEACE OFFICER, FIREFIGHTER, OR MEDICAL FIRST
- 2 RESPONDER WHO, AT THE SCENE OF A MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENT, STEALS ANY
- 3 PROPERTY FROM A PERSON INVOLVED IN THAT ACCIDENT OR FROM A MOTOR
- 4 VEHICLE INVOLVED IN THAT ACCIDENT IS GUILTY OF A FELONY PUNISHABLE
  - BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 20 YEARS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE
  - THAN \$10,000.00, OR BOTH.

- (A) "FIREFIGHTER" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 2 OF
