## **SENATE BILL No. 725**

September 5, 2007, Introduced by Senators CHERRY, GLEASON, OLSHOVE, ANDERSON, WHITMER, SWITALSKI, BRATER, CLARKE, HUNTER, JACOBS, CLARK-COLEMAN, SCOTT, SCHAUER, PRUSI and BASHAM and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources and Environmental Affairs.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 32722 (MCL 324.32722), as added by 2006 PA 33; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 32722. (1) BY FEBRUARY 28, 2008, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
- MAKE AVAILABLE THROUGH ITS INTERNET WEB PAGE A WATER WITHDRAWAL
- 3 ASSESSMENT TOOL TO EDUCATE THE PUBLIC ON POTENTIAL RESOURCE IMPACTS
- OF A WATER WITHDRAWAL, TO INDICATE WHETHER OR NOT A WATER
- WITHDRAWAL IS LIKELY TO CAUSE AN ADVERSE RESOURCE IMPACT, AND TO
- FACILITATE REGISTRATION OF A PROPOSED WATER WITHDRAWAL AS REQUIRED
- 7 BY SECTION 32705.
  - (2) A PERSON MAY BEGIN A NEW OR INCREASED LARGE QUANTITY

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- 1 WITHDRAWAL AFTER THE WATER WITHDRAWAL ASSESSMENT TOOL BECOMES
- 2 EFFECTIVE IF 1 OF THE FOLLOWING APPLIES:
- 3 (A) THE WITHDRAWAL IS REGISTERED AFTER THE WITHDRAWAL
- 4 ASSESSMENT TOOL HAS INDICATED THAT THE WITHDRAWAL IS NOT LIKELY TO
- 5 CAUSE AN ADVERSE RESOURCE IMPACT.
- 6 (B) THE WITHDRAWAL IS REGISTERED AFTER THE DEPARTMENT
- 7 DETERMINES, USING SITE-SPECIFIC FLOW AND OTHER READILY AVAILABLE
- 8 INFORMATION, THAT A WITHDRAWAL IS NOT LIKELY TO CAUSE AN ADVERSE
- 9 RESOURCE IMPACT.
- 10 (C) THE WITHDRAWAL RECEIVES A PERMIT UNDER SECTION 32723.
- 11 (3) THERE IS A REBUTTABLE PRESUMPTION THAT A NEW OR INCREASED
- 12 LARGE QUANTITY WITHDRAWAL THAT IS REGISTERED OR PERMITTED IN
- 13 ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (2) IS NOT LIKELY TO CAUSE AN ADVERSE
- 14 RESOURCE IMPACT IN VIOLATION OF SECTION 32721.
- 15 (4) A PERSON CONSIDERING A NEW OR INCREASED LARGE QUANTITY
- 16 WITHDRAWAL MAY USE THE WATER WITHDRAWAL ASSESSMENT TOOL TO INDICATE
- 17 WHETHER OR NOT THE WITHDRAWAL IS LIKELY TO CAUSE AN ADVERSE
- 18 RESOURCE IMPACT. ALTERNATIVELY, A PERSON CONSIDERING A NEW OR
- 19 INCREASED LARGE QUANTITY WITHDRAWAL MAY REQUEST THAT THE DEPARTMENT
- 20 USE THE WATER WITHDRAWAL ASSESSMENT TOOL FOR THAT PURPOSE AND
- 21 REGISTER THAT PERSON UNDER SECTION 32705. THE DEPARTMENT MAY
- 22 ESTABLISH A FEE, NOT TO EXCEED \$150.00, FOR SUCH A REQUEST.
- 23 (5) A PERSON MAY SEEK A DETERMINATION FROM THE DEPARTMENT
- 24 PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (2)(B) THAT A NEW OR INCREASED LARGE
- 25 QUANTITY WITHDRAWAL IS NOT LIKELY TO CAUSE AN ADVERSE RESOURCE
- 26 IMPACT FOR PURPOSES OF REGISTRATION BY SUBMITTING INFORMATION ON A
- 27 FORM DEVELOPED BY THE DEPARTMENT AND A FEE IN AN AMOUNT ESTABLISHED

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- 1 BY THE DEPARTMENT NOT TO EXCEED \$500.00.
- 2 (6) THE DEPARTMENT, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF
- 3 NATURAL RESOURCES, SHALL UPDATE THE WATER WITHDRAWAL ASSESSMENT
- 4 TOOL AT LEAST ANNUALLY TO MAINTAIN THE ASSESSMENT TOOL AND TO
- 5 INCORPORATE ANY DATA OR METHODS FOR PROCESSING DATA THAT WILL HELP
- 6 IMPROVE ITS ABILITY TO PREDICT IMPACTS FROM PROPOSED WATER
- 7 WITHDRAWALS.
- 8 (7) IF ACCORDING TO THE WATER WITHDRAWAL ASSESSMENT TOOL A
- 9 PORTION OF THE STATE IS CONSISTENTLY SHOWN TO BE AT RISK FOR
- 10 ADVERSE RESOURCE IMPACTS, THE DEPARTMENT MAY DESIGNATE THAT AREA AS
- 11 A SENSITIVE WATER RESOURCE. AFTER THE DEPARTMENT DESIGNATES AN AREA
- 12 AS A SENSITIVE WATER RESOURCE, THE DEPARTMENT MAY MODIFY WATER
- 13 WITHDRAWAL PERMITS THAT AFFECT THE WATER RESOURCE AND MAY REQUIRE
- 14 PERMITS FOR A NEW OR INCREASED LARGE QUANTITY WITHDRAWAL WITHIN THE
- 15 AREA.
- 16 (8) (1) Until a water withdrawal assessment tool becomes
- 17 effective upon legislative enactment pursuant to the
- 18 recommendations of the groundwater conservation advisory council
- 19 under section 32803 FEBRUARY 28, 2008, there is a rebuttable
- 20 presumption that a new or increased large quantity withdrawal will
- 21 not cause an adverse resource impact in violation of section 32721
- 22 under either of the following circumstances:
- 23 (a) The location of the withdrawal is more than 1,320 feet
- 24 from the banks of a designated trout stream.
- 25 (b) The withdrawal depth of the well is at least 150 feet.
- 26 (9)  $\frac{(2)}{(2)}$  A presumption under subsection  $\frac{(1)}{(3)}$  OR (8) may be
- 27 rebutted by a preponderance of evidence that a new or increased

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- 1 large quantity withdrawal from the waters of the state has caused
- 2 or is likely to cause an adverse resource impact.
- 3 Enacting section 1. Section 32724 of the natural resources and
- 4 environmental protection act, 1994 PA 451, MCL 324.32724, is
- 5 repealed.
- 6 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 7 unless all of the following bills of the 94th Legislature are
- 8 enacted into law:
