- 3 accrues at the time provided in sections 5829 to 5838 , and OR, in
- 4 cases not covered by these sections the claim accrues at the time
- 5 the wrong upon which the claim is based was done regardless of the
- 6 time when damage results 5829 TO 5838, WHEN THE PLAINTIFF DISCOVERS
 - OR THROUGH THE EXERCISE OF REASONABLE DILIGENCE SHOULD HAVE
- 8 DISCOVERED THE ELEMENTS OF THE CAUSE OF ACTION, INCLUDING THE
- IDENTITY OF THE DEFENDANT.
