

# SENATE BILL No. 922

November 28, 2007, Introduced by Senator GLEASON and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend 1982 PA 204, entitled  
"Deaf persons' interpreters act,"  
(MCL 393.501 to 393.509) by adding section 8f.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1        SEC. 8F. (1) THE INTERPRETERS' STANDARDS FUND IS CREATED  
2        WITHIN THE STATE TREASURY.

3        (2) THE STATE TREASURER MAY RECEIVE MONEY OR OTHER ASSETS FROM  
4        ANY SOURCE FOR DEPOSIT INTO THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL  
5        DIRECT THE INVESTMENT OF THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL CREDIT  
6        TO THE FUND INTEREST AND EARNINGS FROM FUND INVESTMENTS.

7        (3) MONEY IN THE FUND AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR SHALL  
8        REMAIN IN THE FUND AND SHALL NOT LAPSE TO THE GENERAL FUND.

9        (4) THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND ECONOMIC GROWTH SHALL BE THE  
10       ADMINISTRATOR OF THE FUND FOR AUDITING PURPOSES.

1           (5) THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND ECONOMIC GROWTH SHALL EXPEND  
2 MONEY FROM THE FUND TO COVER COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE DIVISION ON  
3 DEAF AND HARD OF HEARING WITHIN THE COMMISSION ON DISABILITY  
4 CONCERNS.
