A bill to amend 2006 PA 272, entitled "Renewable fuels commission act," by amending sections 3 and 6 (MCL 290.583 and 290.586).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 3. (1) The renewable fuels commission is established
within the department of agriculture. The commission shall
investigate and recommend strategies that the governor and the
legislature may implement to promote the use of alternative fuels
and encourage the use of vehicles that utilize alternative fuels.
The commission shall also identify mechanisms that promote research
into alternative fuels.

(2) The commission shall identify mechanisms that promote effective communication and coordination of efforts between this state and local governments, private industry, and institutes of

- 3 (3) The commission may also review any state regulation that
- 4 may hinder the use, research, and development of alternative fuels

- Sec. 6. This act is repealed effective January 1, 2010 2012.
