A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code," by amending section 684 (MCL 257.684).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 684. (a) Every A vehicle upon a highway within this state

at any time from a half hour after sunset to a half hour before sunrise and at any other time when there is not sufficient light to render clearly discernible persons and vehicles on the highway at a distance of 500 feet ahead shall display lighted lamps and illuminating devices as hereinafter respectively required UNDER THIS CHAPTER for different classes of vehicles, subject to exceptions with respect to FOR parked vehicles as hereinafter stated PROVIDED UNDER THIS CHAPTER.
