## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 3F. (1) THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL MAY DISAPPROVE THE
- 2 UNRESTRICTED SALE OF ANY NOVELTY LIGHTER IF THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL
- 3 DETERMINES THAT THE DEVICE DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY MAY CAUSE HARM TO
  - THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY, OR WELFARE.
  - (2) THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL MAY, AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 2A,
    - PROMULGATE RULES TO SET STANDARDS FOR MAKING THE DETERMINATION
    - DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1) AND MAY APPOINT AN AD HOC COMMITTEE TO
  - MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING THE CONTENT OF THE RULES.
    - (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "NOVELTY LIGHTER" MEANS A DEVICE
