- 2 PROVIDED UNDER THIS ACT SHALL ONLY BE USED FOR 1 OR MORE OF THE
- 3 FOLLOWING PURPOSES:
 - (A) LAW ENFORCEMENT IDENTIFICATION PURPOSES.
- 5 (B) TO ASSIST IN THE RECOVERY OR IDENTIFICATION OF HUMAN
- 6 REMAINS OR MISSING PERSONS.
- 7 (C) ACADEMIC, RESEARCH, STATISTICAL ANALYSIS, OR PROTOCOL
- 8 DEVELOPMENT PURPOSES ONLY IF PERSONAL IDENTIFIERS ARE REMOVED.
 - (2) DNA SAMPLES PROVIDED UNDER THIS ACT SHALL NOT BE ANALYZED
