

SENATE BILL No. 1386

June 17, 2008, Introduced by Senators WHITMER, PAPPAGEORGE, BASHAM, SWITALSKI, KUIPERS, GLEASON and HARDIMAN and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1990 PA 250, entitled
"DNA identification profiling system act,"
(MCL 28.171 to 28.176) by adding section 5.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 5. (1) THE DNA PROFILES OF DNA SAMPLES AUTHORIZED TO BE
2 PROVIDED UNDER THIS ACT SHALL ONLY BE USED FOR 1 OR MORE OF THE
3 FOLLOWING PURPOSES:

4 (A) LAW ENFORCEMENT IDENTIFICATION PURPOSES.

5 (B) TO ASSIST IN THE RECOVERY OR IDENTIFICATION OF HUMAN
6 REMAINS OR MISSING PERSONS.

7 (C) ACADEMIC, RESEARCH, STATISTICAL ANALYSIS, OR PROTOCOL
8 DEVELOPMENT PURPOSES ONLY IF PERSONAL IDENTIFIERS ARE REMOVED.

9 (2) DNA SAMPLES PROVIDED UNDER THIS ACT SHALL NOT BE ANALYZED

1 FOR IDENTIFICATION OF ANY MEDICAL OR GENETIC DISORDER.
