THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 17766G. (1) A PERSON WHO POSSESSES NONPRESCRIPTION COUGH
- 2 OR COLD MEDICINE THAT CONTAINS DEXTROMETHORPHAN FOR RETAIL SALE
- 3 PURSUANT TO A LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THE GENERAL SALES TAX ACT, 1933
- 4 PA 167, MCL 205.51 TO 205.78, SHALL NOT SELL THAT PRODUCT TO AN
- 5 INDIVIDUAL UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE. THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A
- 6 PRESCRIPTION COUGH AND COLD MEDICINE THAT CONTAINS
- 7 DEXTROMETHORPHAN. AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "DEXTROMETHORPHAN" MEANS
- 8 DEXTROROTATORY ISOMER OF 3-METHOXY-N-METHYLMORPHINAN AND ITS SALTS.
- 9 (2) IT IS AN AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSE TO A CITATION ISSUED UNDER
- O SUBSECTION (1) THAT THE DEFENDANT HAD IN FORCE AT THE TIME OF THE

- 1 CITATION AND CONTINUES TO HAVE IN FORCE A WRITTEN POLICY FOR
- 2 EMPLOYEES TO PREVENT THE SALE OF NONPRESCRIPTION COUGH OR COLD
- 3 MEDICINE THAT CONTAINS DEXTROMETHORPHAN TO PERSONS UNDER 18 YEARS
- 4 OF AGE AND THAT THE DEFENDANT ENFORCED AND CONTINUES TO ENFORCE THE
- 5 POLICY. A DEFENDANT WHO PROPOSES TO OFFER EVIDENCE OF THE
- 6 AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSE DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBSECTION SHALL FILE AND

- 19 ACT OF 1961, 1961 PA 236, MCL 600.8801 TO 600.8835, AND MAY BE
- 20 ORDERED TO PAY A CIVIL FINE AS FOLLOWS:
- 21 (A) FOR THE FIRST OFFENSE, A CIVIL FINE OF NOT MORE THAN
- 22 \$1,000.00.
- 23 (B) FOR THE SECOND OFFENSE, A CIVIL FINE OF NOT MORE THAN
- 24 \$2,000.00.
- 25 (C) FOR THE THIRD OR SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE, A CIVIL FINE OF NOT
- 26 MORE THAN \$5,000.00.
