

SENATE BILL No. 1543

September 25, 2008, Introduced by Senator BROWN and referred to the Committee on Energy Policy and Public Utilities.

A bill to amend 1986 PA 32, entitled "Emergency 9-1-1 service enabling act," by amending sections 407 and 717 (MCL 484.1407 and 484.1717), as amended by 2007 PA 165.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 407. (1) The emergency 9-1-1 fund is created within the
2 state treasury.

3 (2) The state treasurer may receive money or other assets as
4 provided under this act and from any source for deposit into the
5 fund. Money may be deposited into the fund by electronic funds
6 transfer. Money in the CMRS emergency telephone fund on ~~the~~
7 ~~effective date of the amendatory act that added section 401a~~ **JULY**
8 **1, 2008** shall be deposited into the fund and expended as provided
9 by this act. The state treasurer shall direct the investment of the

1 fund. The state treasurer shall credit to the fund interest and
2 earnings from fund investments.

3 (3) Money in the fund at the close of the fiscal year shall
4 remain in the fund and shall not lapse to the general fund.

5 (4) The department of treasury shall expend money from the
6 fund only as provided in this act. The disbursement of money may be
7 by electronic funds transfer.

8 (5) The auditor general shall audit the fund at least
9 annually.
