November 6, 2007, Introduced by Rep. Dean and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A joint resolution proposing an amendment to the state constitution of 1963, by amending section 31 of article IV and by adding section 55 to article IV, to provide that certain state budget bills be presented to the governor on or before a certain date and to reduce compensation of state legislators when certain state budget bills are not presented on or before a certain date.

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the state of Michigan, That the following amendment to the state constitution of 1963, to provide that certain state budget bills be presented to the governor on or before a certain date and to reduce compensation of state legislators when certain state budget bills are not presented on or before a certain date, is proposed, agreed

to, and submitted to the people of the state:

- 1 ARTICLE IV
- 2 Sec. 31. The general appropriation bills for the succeeding
- 3 fiscal period covering items set forth in the budget shall be
- 4 passed or rejected in either house of the legislature before that
- 5 house passes any appropriation bill for items not in the budget
- 6 except bills supplementing appropriations for the current fiscal
- 7 year's operation. Any bill requiring an appropriation to carry out
- 8 its purpose shall be considered an appropriation bill. One of the
- 9 general appropriation bills as passed by the legislature shall
- 10 contain an itemized statement of estimated revenue by major source
- 11 in each operating fund for the ensuing fiscal period, the total of
- 12 which shall not be less than the total of all appropriations made
- 13 from each fund in the general appropriation bills as passed. THE
- 14 LEGISLATURE SHALL PRESENT ALL GENERAL APPROPRIATION BILLS FOR THE
- 15 SUCCEEDING FISCAL PERIOD TO THE GOVERNOR AT LEAST FIFTEEN DAYS
- 16 BEFORE THE START OF THE FISCAL YEAR.
- 17 SEC. 55. IF THE LEGISLATURE HAS NOT PRESENTED ALL GENERAL
- 18 APPROPRIATION BILLS FOR THE SUCCEEDING FISCAL PERIOD TO THE
- 19 GOVERNOR BY THE TIME PERIOD SET FORTH IN SECTION 31, EACH
- 20 LEGISLATOR SHALL FORFEIT HIS OR HER SALARY UNTIL ALL THE GENERAL
- 21 APPROPRIATION BILLS HAVE BEEN PRESENTED.
- 22 Resolved further, That the foregoing amendment shall be
- 23 submitted to the people of the state at the next general election
- 24 in the manner provided by law.
