

# HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 000

October 29, 2008, Introduced by Rep. Bieda and referred to the Committee on Ethics and Elections.

A joint resolution proposing an amendment to the state constitution of 1963, by adding section 21a to article V, to provide for the filling of a vacancy in the office of lieutenant governor.

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the state of Michigan, That the following amendment to the state constitution of 1963, to provide for the filling of a vacancy in the office of lieutenant governor, is proposed, agreed to, and submitted to the people of the state:

## ARTICLE V

SEC. 21A. IF THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR SUCCEEDS TO THE OFFICE OF GOVERNOR AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 26 OF THIS ARTICLE, OR IF A VACANCY

1 OTHERWISE OCCURS IN THE OFFICE OF LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR, THE GOVERNOR  
2 SHALL NOMINATE A LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR, WHO SHALL TAKE OFFICE UPON  
3 CONFIRMATION BY A MAJORITY VOTE OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED TO AND  
4 SERVING IN EACH HOUSE.

5 Resolved further, That the foregoing amendment shall be  
6 submitted to the people of the state at the next general election  
7 in the manner provided by law.
