**House Resolution No. 84.**

Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of this legislative body recognize May 1, 2007, as Law Day in the state of Michigan; and be it further

Resolved, That the citizens, schools, businesses, and media of the state of Michigan are encouraged to use this occasion to preserve and strengthen the rule of law.
