JUROR FUND: SURPLUS TO COURT EQUITY FUND

A SUMMARY OF SENATE BILL 776 AS PASSED THE SENATE October 14, 2009 (with assumed amendment):

Under the Revised Judicature Act, the unencumbered balance of the Juror Compensation Reimbursement Fund remaining in the fund at the end of a fiscal year remains in the fund and does not revert to the General Fund. SB 776 would amend the act to specify that \$1.35 million of the unencumbered balance in the juror compensation fund at the end of FY 2008-09 be transferred to the Court Equity Fund.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The bill would implement a \$1.35 million fund transfer assumed in the FY 2009-10 Judiciary budget to meet agreed upon general fund target reductions.
