## **HOUSE BILL No. 5959**

(As amended May 4, 2010)

March 17, 2010, Introduced by Reps. Warren, Smith and Kennedy and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1975 PA 46, entitled

"An act to create the office of the legislative corrections ombudsman; to prescribe the powers and duties of the office, the ombudsman, the legislative council, and the department of corrections; and to provide remedies from administrative acts,"

by amending section 5 (MCL 4.355).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 5. (1) Upon request [AND WITHOUT THE REQUIREMENT OF ANY RELEASE], the ombudsman shall be given access
- 2 to all information, records, and documents in the possession of the
- 3 department which the ombudsman deems necessary in an investigation,
- 4 INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, PRISONER MEDICAL HEALTH RECORDS,
- 5 PRISONER MENTAL HEALTH RECORDS, AND PRISONER MORTALITY AND
- 6 MORBIDITY RECORDS. The department shall assist the ombudsman in
- 7 obtaining the necessary releases of those documents which are
- 8 specifically restricted or privileged for use by the ombudsman.
  - (2) Upon request and without notice, the ombudsman shall be

- 1 granted entrance to inspect at any time any premises under the

- 3 (3) The ombudsman may hold informal hearings and may request
- 4 that any person appear before the ombudsman, or at a hearing, and
