SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 6270

A bill to amend 1967 PA 150, entitled "Michigan military act," by amending section 306 (MCL 32.706).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 306. The BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2011, THE adjutant general
- 2 and the assistant adjutants general WHO BEGAN EMPLOYMENT ON OR
- 3 AFTER JANUARY 1, 2011 when relieved under honorable circumstances τ
- 4 shall be placed on the retired list of the national guard. The
- 5 adjutant general and assistant adjutants general shall receive
- 6 retirement pay equal to the retirement pay which an officer of like
- 7 grade and total longevity would receive as indicated in appropriate
- 8 federal regulations when they are retired or honorably relieved.
- 9 Such retirement pay SHALL RECEIVE RETIREMENT BENEFITS AS A
- 10 QUALIFIED PARTICIPANT UNDER THE STATE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT ACT,

- 1 1943 PA 240, MCL 38.1 TO 38.69. RETIREMENT BENEFITS will start on
- 2 the date of retirement or honorable relief from duty. Retirement
- 3 under this section requires not less than 20 years active service
- 4 with the national guard and/or state defense force. Any retirement
- 5 pay received from the federal government for military service will
- 6 be deducted when computing the amount received from the state. The
- 7 deduction shall start on the first day of the month the officer
- 8 becomes eligible for federal retirement. Once established, the
- 9 amount of the deduction shall not be changed; however, it shall not
- 10 deprive such a retired officer from receiving a total of state and
- 11 federal pay equal to that authorized to officers of like grade and
- 12 total longevity who are retired from the active federal armed
- 13 forces.
- 14 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 15 unless House Bill No. 6271 of the 95th Legislature is enacted into
- **16** law.
