SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4172

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 21530; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 21530. (1) DURING THE INFLUENZA SEASON, IF A HOSPITAL HAS
- 2 INFLUENZA VACCINE AVAILABLE AND CONSISTENT WITH THE HOSPITAL'S
- 3 SEASONAL INFLUENZA IMMUNIZATION POLICY ESTABLISHED UNDER SECTION
- 4 21529, THE HOSPITAL SHALL INFORM INDIVIDUALS IDENTIFIED IN THE
- 5 POLICY WHO ARE ADMITTED TO THE HOSPITAL FOR A PERIOD OF 24 HOURS OR
- 6 MORE THAT THE INFLUENZA VACCINE IS AVAILABLE AND OFFER TO PROVIDE
- 7 THE VACCINE TO THOSE INDIVIDUALS FOR WHOM THE VACCINE IS NOT
- 8 MEDICALLY CONTRAINDICATIVE. IF AN INDIVIDUAL CONSENTS TO BE

- IMMUNIZED AGAINST THE INFLUENZA VIRUS AND A PHYSICIAN, PHYSICIAN'S 1
- 2 ASSISTANT, NURSE, PHARMACIST, OR OTHER INDEPENDENT PRACTICING
- 3 LICENSED HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONAL DETERMINES THAT THERE IS NOT AN
- AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE OPPOSED TO GIVING THE VACCINE OR AN 4
- 5 ABSOLUTE MEDICAL CONTRAINDICATION TO GIVING THE VACCINE, THE HEALTH
- CARE PROFESSIONAL SHALL ADMINISTER THE INFLUENZA VACCINATION TO THE 6
- INDIVIDUAL BEFORE HE OR SHE IS DISCHARGED FROM THE HOSPITAL AND 7
- SHALL DOCUMENT THE VACCINATION IN THE MANNER PRESCRIBED IN THE 8
- SEASONAL INFLUENZA IMMUNIZATION POLICY.
- 10 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "INFLUENZA SEASON" MEANS THAT
- 11 PERIOD BETWEEN OCTOBER 1 AND MARCH 1.
- 12 (3) THIS SECTION IS REPEALED EFFECTIVE APRIL 1, 2012.
- Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect 13
- 14 unless Senate Bill No. 722 of the 95th Legislature is enacted into
- 15 law.
