4 PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS

5 **GENERAL SECTIONS**

6 Sec. 201. In accordance with the provisions of section 30 of
 7 article IX of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending
 8 from state resources in this appropriation act for the fiscal year
 9 ending September 30, 2010 is \$7,391,500.00 and state appropriations
 10 paid to local units of government are \$0.00.

11 Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized
 12 under this act and the departments, commissions, boards, offices,
 13 and programs for which appropriations are made under this act are
 14 subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101
 15 to 18.1594.

11 **DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE**

12 Sec. 802. From the amount appropriated in part 1 for purses
13 and supplements - fairs/licensed tracks, \$140,000.00 is to be used
14 for state purse supplements at state licensed pari-mutuel tracks
15 for races composed only of Michigan-bred horses segregated into a
16 4-year-old colt trot division, a 4-year-old filly trot division, a
17 4-year-old colt pace division, and a 4-year-old filly pace
18 division.

19 Sec. 803. Included in the appropriation made in part 1 for the
20 thoroughbred program is \$15,000.00 for the Michigan united
21 thoroughbred breeders and owners association to conduct a
22 thoroughbred yearling show. The Michigan united thoroughbred
23 breeders and owners association shall submit to the department an
24 itemized list of expenses showing that the expenses of the yearling
25 show were paid.

26 Sec. 804. From the funds appropriated in part 1 for

House Bill No. 4288 (H-1) as amended October 29, 2009 (1 of 2)
1 thoroughbred owners' awards, awards shall be distributed pursuant
2 to section 20 of the horse racing law of 1995, 1995 PA 279, MCL
3 431.320.

4 Sec. 807. Of the amount appropriated in part 1 for purses and
5 supplements - fairs/licensed tracks, a sufficient amount is
6 appropriated to provide for overnight purse supplements pursuant to
7 the horse racing law of 1995, 1995 PA 279, MCL 431.301 to 431.336.

8 Sec. 811. The funds appropriated in part 1 for distribution of
9 outstanding winning tickets are not available for expenditure until
10 they are deposited in the Michigan agriculture equine industry
11 development fund pursuant to section 2 of 1951 PA 90, MCL 431.252.
12 These funds shall be expended in accordance with section 2 of 1951
13 PA 90, MCL 431.252. The department shall provide notice to the
14 senate and house appropriations subcommittees on agriculture at
15 least 10 days before the funds are expended. This notice shall
16 include the amount that each program receives from the outstanding
17 winning ticket revenue deposited in the Michigan agriculture equine
18 industry development fund.

[Sec. 812. In the event there is no live thoroughbred race meet in
2009 or 2010, all purse money and program money appropriated for the
thoroughbred industry in fiscal year 2008-2009 and fiscal year 2009-2010
shall be held in escrow for a period not to exceed 18 months, or until a
thoroughbred race meet license is applied for and granted by the office
of racing commissioner. In the event there is no thoroughbred race meet
in 2009 or 2010, the purse pool distribution order to be issued by the
office of racing commissioner in 2010 that delineates distribution
between the thoroughbred race meet that has been held at Great Lakes
downs and the joint thoroughbred/quarterhorse meet held in Mt. Pleasant
shall be the same distribution formula as issued in 2009, with the
thoroughbred portion being held in escrow.]

Sec. 813. The office of racing commissioner shall provide each
certified horsemen's organization a minimum of 30 days notice before
submitting a request for rule-making with the state office of
administrative hearings and rules. The notice shall include all
information as is required by the request for rule-making with the state
office of administrative hearings and rules.]
