### 21 GENERAL SECTIONS

Sec. 201. In accordance with the provisions of section 30 of article IX of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending from state resources in this appropriation act for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2009 is \$160,000.00 and state appropriations

- 1 paid to local units of government are \$0.
- 2 Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized
- 3 under this act and the departments, commissions, boards, offices,
- 4 and programs for which appropriations are made under this act are
- 5 subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101
- 6 to 18.1594.
- 7 Sec. 203. (1) In addition to the funds appropriated in part 1,
- 8 there is appropriated an amount equal to any additional federal
- 9 funding awarded to Michigan through recalculation of formulas and
- 10 under the redistribution provisions of the American recovery and
- 11 reinvestment act of 2009, Public Law 111-5.
- 12 (2) Within 30 days of receiving funds described in subsection
- 13 (1), a department shall report to the senate and house standing
- 14 committees on appropriations, senate and house fiscal agencies,
- 15 state budget director, and the governor on the amount of funds
- 16 received and the purposes for which they will be spent.
- 17 Sec. 204. The unexpended funds appropriated in part 1 and in
- 18 section 203, and any unencumbered or unallotted funds, are carried
- 19 forward into the succeeding fiscal year. The following is in
- 20 compliance with section 451a(1) of the management and budget act,
- 21 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1451a:
- 22 (a) The purpose of the projects to be carried forward is to
- 23 protect and invest in the natural resources, infrastructure, and
- 24 people of the State of Michigan in accordance with the provisions
- 25 of the American recovery and reinvestment act of 2009, Public Law
- **26** 111-5.
- 27 (b) The projects will be accomplished by state employees and

- 2 (c) The total estimated cost of abll projects is identified in

- 4 (d) The tentative completion date is September 30, 2012.
- 5 Sec. 205. (1) In a form and manner determined by the recipient
- 6 department, local governments and other eligible subrecipients
- 7 receiving funds through this act shall comply with all requirements
- 8 corresponding to the receipt of funds, including, but not limited
- 9 to, any certifications, assurances, accountability, and
- 10 transparency provisions required in the American recovery and
- 11 reinvestment act of 2009, Public Law 111-5.
- 12 (2) Funds appropriated in part 1 may be transferred to
- 13 subrecipient state departments or agencies in an interdepartmental
- 14 grant consistent with the requirements of the American recovery and
- reinvestment act of 2009, Public Law 111-5.

- Sec. 401. Of the appropriation in part 1 for unemployment
- 18 programs modernization incentive payment from funds received under
- 19 section 903 of the social security act, 42 USC 1103, \$69,500,000.00
- 20 shall be used for the purpose of supporting increased unemployment
- 21 service capacity and technology improvements in the Michigan
- 22 unemployment insurance agency.

- 2 \$150,000.00 shall be distributed to elder law of Michigan to enhance

- funding shall be distributed to the food bank council of Michigan 5
- to assist Michigan food banks in collaborating with anti-hunger 6
