## PART 2

## PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS

**GENERAL SECTIONS**

9 Sec. 201. In accordance with the provisions of section 30 of  
 10 article IX of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending  
 11 from state resources in this appropriation act for the fiscal year  
 12 ending September 30, 2009 is \$400,000.00 and state appropriations  
 13 paid to local units of government are \$0.

14 Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized  
 15 under this act and the departments, commissions, boards, offices,  
 16 and programs for which appropriations are made under this act are  
 17 subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101  
 18 to 18.1594.

**[CAPITAL OUTLAY**

Sec. 251. The design scope of the skilled trades training complex project at Washtenaw community college, authorized for planning in 2008 PA 278, is hereby revised to renovation of occupation education and advanced manufacturing buildings for the purposes of supporting occupational education and training. The project title is hereby revised to skilled trades training program renovations. The total estimated cost of this project is \$14,800,000 (state share \$7,400,000; community college share \$7,400,000).]

**STATE TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT**

20 Sec. 301. (1) From the funds appropriated in part 1 from the  
 21 comprehensive transportation fund for rail passenger service, the  
 22 state transportation department shall negotiate with a rail carrier  
 23 to provide rail service between Grand Rapids and Chicago and  
 24 between Port Huron and Chicago on a 7-day basis, consistent with  
 H01278'09 (H-3)

2 (2) The rail carrier shall, as a condition to receiving a  
3 state operating subsidy, maintain a system to monitor, collect, and  
4 resolve customer complaints and shall make the information  
5 available to the state transportation department, the state budget  
6 director, the house and senate appropriations subcommittees on  
7 transportation, and the house and senate fiscal agencies.
