SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4390

A bill to amend 1939 PA 3, entitled

"An act to provide for the regulation and control of public and certain private utilities and other services affected with a public interest within this state; to provide for alternative energy suppliers; to provide for licensing; to include municipally owned utilities and other providers of energy under certain provisions of this act; to create a public service commission and to prescribe and define its powers and duties; to abolish the Michigan public utilities commission and to confer the powers and duties vested by law on the public service commission; to provide for the continuance, transfer, and completion of certain matters and proceedings; to abolish automatic adjustment clauses; to prohibit certain rate increases without notice and hearing; to qualify residential energy conservation programs permitted under state law for certain federal exemption; to create a fund; to provide for a restructuring of the manner in which energy is provided in this state; to encourage the utilization of resource recovery facilities; to prohibit certain acts and practices of providers of energy; to allow for the securitization of stranded costs; to reduce rates; to provide for appeals; to provide appropriations; to declare the effect and purpose of this act; to prescribe remedies and penalties; and to repeal acts and parts of acts,"

(MCL 460.1 to 460.11) by adding section 6t.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 6T. (1) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (2),
- 2 AN ELECTRIC PROVIDER SHALL NOT USE AN ELECTRIC SERVICE LIMITER IN
- 3 THIS STATE. THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO ADVANCED METERS
- 4 EXCEPT TO THE EXTENT AN ADVANCED METER IS USED TO PERFORM THE
- 5 FUNCTION OF AN ELECTRIC SERVICE LIMITER.
- 6 (2) NO LATER THAN OCTOBER 1, 2009, THE COMMISSION SHALL ISSUE
- 7 A TEMPORARY ORDER THAT ESTABLISHES UNIFORM STANDARDS FOR THE USE OF
- 8 ELECTRIC SERVICE LIMITERS AND ADVANCED METERS TO THE EXTENT THEY
- 9 ARE USED TO PERFORM THE FUNCTION OF AN ELECTRIC SERVICE LIMITER BY
- 10 ELECTRIC PROVIDERS IN THIS STATE. SUBSECTION (1) DOES NOT APPLY ON
- 11 OR AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE TEMPORARY ORDER.
- 12 (3) WITHIN 1 YEAR AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE AMENDATORY
- 13 ACT THAT ADDED THIS SECTION, THE COMMISSION SHALL PROMULGATE RULES
- 14 ESTABLISHING UNIFORM STANDARDS FOR THE USE OF ELECTRIC SERVICE
- 15 LIMITERS AND ADVANCED METERS TO THE EXTENT THEY ARE USED TO PERFORM
- 16 THE FUNCTION OF AN ELECTRIC SERVICE LIMITER BY ELECTRIC PROVIDERS
- 17 IN THIS STATE PURSUANT TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES ACT OF
- 18 1969, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201 TO 24.328. UPON PROMULGATION OF THE
- 19 RULES, THE ORDER UNDER SUBSECTION (2) IS RESCINDED.
- 20 (4) AN ELECTRIC PROVIDER SHALL NOT USE AN ELECTRIC SERVICE
- 21 LIMITER AT A KNOWN SENIOR CITIZEN CUSTOMER'S HOUSEHOLD OR A
- 22 HOUSEHOLD IN WHICH A KNOWN MEDICAL EMERGENCY EXISTS IN THIS STATE.
- 23 (5) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 24 (A) "ADVANCED METER" MEANS AN ELECTRIC METER WHICH MEETS 1 OR
- 25 MORE OF THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:
- 26 (i) MEASURES AND RECORDS USAGE DATA IN TIME DIFFERENTIATED

- 1 REGISTERS, INCLUDING HOURLY OR OTHER INTERVALS.
- 2 (ii) ALLOWS ELECTRIC CONSUMERS AND ELECTRIC SERVICE PROVIDERS
- 3 TO PARTICIPATE IN PRICE-BASED DEMAND RESPONSE PROGRAMS, INCLUDING
- 4 REMOTE SERVICE SWITCH CAPABILITY ACTIVATED BY INTERVENING DIRECTION
- 5 FROM THE ELECTRIC PROVIDER.
- 6 (iii) PROVIDES OTHER DATA AND FUNCTIONALITY THAT ADDRESS POWER
- 7 QUALITY AND OTHER ELECTRICITY SERVICE ISSUES.
- 8 (B) "ELECTRIC PROVIDER" MEANS AN ELECTRIC UTILITY, MUNICIPALLY
- 9 OWNED ELECTRIC UTILITY, COOPERATIVE ELECTRIC UTILITY, OR
- 10 ALTERNATIVE ELECTRIC SUPPLIER.
- 11 (C) "ELECTRIC SERVICE LIMITER" MEANS AN ELECTRIC METER OR
- 12 DEVICE USED IN CONJUNCTION WITH AN ELECTRIC METER THAT
- 13 AUTOMATICALLY INTERRUPTS ALL ELECTRIC SERVICE TO A CUSTOMER WITHOUT
- 14 INTERVENING DIRECTION FROM THE ELECTRIC PROVIDER WHEN A UTILITY
- 15 IMPOSED PEAK USAGE LIMIT IS EXCEEDED.
- 16 (D) "MEDICAL EMERGENCY" MEANS AN EXISTING MEDICAL CONDITION OF
- 17 THE CUSTOMER OR A MEMBER OF THE CUSTOMER'S HOUSEHOLD, AS DEFINED
- 18 AND CERTIFIED BY A PHYSICIAN OR PUBLIC HEALTH OFFICIAL ON OFFICIAL
- 19 STATIONERY OR COMPANY-PROVIDED FORM, THAT WILL BE AGGRAVATED BY THE
- 20 LACK OF UTILITY SERVICE.
- 21 (E) "SENIOR CITIZEN CUSTOMER" MEANS AN ELECTRIC PROVIDER
- 22 CUSTOMER WHO IS 65 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER.
