## SUBSTITUTE FOR

## HOUSE BILL NO. 4663

## A bill to amend 1969 PA 224, entitled

"An act to license and regulate dealers in and research facilities using dogs and cats for research purposes; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,"

by amending sections 1, 8, and 9 (MCL 287.381, 287.388, and 287.389); and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. When AS used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Person" includes any individual, partnership,
- 3 association, or corporation.
- 4 (b) "Director" means the director of the department of
- 5 agriculture.
- 6 (A) "ANIMAL BLOOD BANKING" MEANS THE PROVISION OF VETERINARY

- 1 TRANSFUSION PRODUCTS THROUGH SPECIES-SPECIFIC DONATION.
- 2 (B) "ANIMAL CONTROL SHELTER" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN
- 3 SECTION 1 OF 1969 PA 287, MCL 287.331, AND THAT IS REGISTERED UNDER
- 4 THAT ACT.
- 5 (C) "ANIMAL PROTECTION SHELTER" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN
- 6 SECTION 1 OF 1969 PA 287, MCL 287.331, AND THAT IS REGISTERED UNDER
- 7 THAT ACT.
- 8 (D) <del>(c)</del> "Cat" means any live domestic cat <del>(felis OF THE</del>
- 9 SPECIES FELIS catus. ) for use or intended to be used for research,
- 10 tests or experiments at research facilities.
- 11 (E) "DEALER" MEANS A PERSON WHO FOR COMPENSATION OR PROFIT
- 12 DELIVERS FOR TRANSPORTATION, TRANSPORTS, BOARDS, BUYS, OR SELLS
- 13 DOGS OR CATS FOR RESEARCH PURPOSES AND DOES NOT INCLUDE A PERSON
- 14 WHO BREEDS OR RAISES DOGS OR CATS ON HIS OR HER PREMISES FOR SALE
- 15 TO A RESEARCH FACILITY.
- 16 (F) "DIRECTOR" MEANS THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
- 17 AGRICULTURE.
- 18 (G) (d)—"Dog" means any live dog of the species canis—CANIS
- 19 familiaris. for use or intended to be used for research tests or
- 20 experiments at research facilities.
- 21 (H) "PERSON" INCLUDES ANY INDIVIDUAL, LIMITED LIABILITY
- 22 COMPANY, PARTNERSHIP, ASSOCIATION, OR CORPORATION.
- 23 (I) <del>(e)</del> "Research facility" means any school, hospital,
- 24 laboratory, institution, organization, or person that uses or
- 25 intends to use dogs or cats in research, tests TESTING, or
- 26 experiments, and that (1) purchases—DOES 1 OR BOTH OF THE
- 27 FOLLOWING:

- 1 (i) PURCHASES, RECEIVES, or transports such animals, or (2)
  2 receives DOGS OR CATS.
- 3 (ii) RECEIVES any funds from the THIS state or A local
- 4 government or any agency or instrumentality thereof to finance its
- 5 operations by means of grants, loans, or otherwise.
- 6 (f) "Dealer" means any person who for compensation or profit
- 7 delivers for transportation, transports, boards, buys or sells dogs
- 8 or cats for research purposes and does not mean a person who breeds
- 9 or raises dogs or cats for sale to a research facility.
- 10 Sec. 8. (1) A dealer —OR a county, city, village, or township
- 11 operating a dog pound or animal CONTROL SHELTER OR ANIMAL
- 12 PROTECTION shelter shall not sell or otherwise dispose of a dog or
- 13 cat within 4 days after its acquisition. If the dog or cat has a
- 14 collar, license, or other evidence of ownership, the operator of
- 15 the pound or ANIMAL CONTROL SHELTER OR ANIMAL PROTECTION shelter
- 16 shall notify the owner in writing and disposition of the animal DOG
- 17 OR CAT shall not be made within 7 days from the date of mailing the
- 18 notice. Each operator of a pound or ANIMAL CONTROL SHELTER OR
- 19 ANIMAL PROTECTION shelter shall be required to maintain a record on
- 20 each identifiable dog or cat acquired, indicating a basic
- 21 description of the animal, the date it was acquired, and under what
- 22 THE circumstances UNDER WHICH IT WAS ACQUIRED. The record shall
- 23 also indicate the date of notice sent to the owner of an animal and
- 24 subsequent disposition. This section SUBSECTION does not apply to
- 25 animals which THAT are sick or injured to the extent that the
- 26 holding period would—IS LIKELY TO cause undue suffering, or to
- 27 animals whose owners request immediate disposal.

- 1 (2) UNTIL THE EXPIRATION OF 12 MONTHS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE
- 2 OF THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS SUBSECTION, A PERSON
- 3 SURRENDERING A DOG OR CAT TO AN ANIMAL CONTROL SHELTER OR AN ANIMAL
- 4 PROTECTION SHELTER HAS THE OPTION OF DESIGNATING, IN WRITING,
- 5 WHETHER THE SURRENDERED DOG OR CAT MAY BE SOLD OR TRANSFERRED TO A
- 6 RESEARCH FACILITY OR DEALER FOR THE PURPOSE OF RESALE FOR
- 7 EXPERIMENTATION. AN ANIMAL CONTROL SHELTER OR ANIMAL PROTECTION
- 8 SHELTER SHALL NOT SELL OR TRANSFER TO A RESEARCH FACILITY OR DEALER
- 9 A DOG OR CAT SURRENDERED BY ITS OWNER UNLESS THE WRITTEN
- 10 DESIGNATION DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBSECTION IS EXECUTED. HOWEVER, IN
- 11 THE CASE OF AN ANIMAL CONTROL SHELTER RECEIVING A DOG OR CAT FOUND
- 12 ON THE STREETS OR RUNNING AT LARGE, THE ANIMAL CONTROL SHELTER
- 13 SHALL NOT SELL OR TRANSFER THE DOG OR CAT TO A DEALER.
- 14 (3) BEGINNING 12 MONTHS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE
- 15 AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS SUBSECTION, A PERSON SURRENDERING A
- 16 DOG OR CAT TO AN ANIMAL CONTROL SHELTER OR AN ANIMAL PROTECTION
- 17 SHELTER HAS THE OPTION OF DESIGNATING, IN WRITING, WHETHER THE
- 18 SURRENDERED DOG OR CAT MAY BE SOLD OR TRANSFERRED TO A RESEARCH
- 19 FACILITY. AN ANIMAL CONTROL SHELTER OR ANIMAL PROTECTION SHELTER
- 20 SHALL NOT SELL OR TRANSFER TO A RESEARCH FACILITY A DOG OR CAT
- 21 SURRENDERED BY ITS OWNER UNLESS THE WRITTEN DESIGNATION DESCRIBED
- 22 IN THIS SUBSECTION IS EXECUTED.
- 23 (4) BEGINNING 12 MONTHS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE
- 24 AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS SUBSECTION, A DEALER SHALL NOT
- 25 ACOUIRE OR PURCHASE A CAT OR DOG FROM AN ANIMAL CONTROL SHELTER OR
- 26 ANIMAL PROTECTION SHELTER. BEGINNING 12 MONTHS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE
- 27 DATE OF THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS SUBSECTION, AN ANIMAL

- 1 CONTROL SHELTER OR ANIMAL PROTECTION SHELTER SHALL NOT SELL,
- 2 PROVIDE, OR OTHERWISE TRANSFER A CAT OR DOG TO A DEALER.
- 3 (5) SUBSECTIONS (2), (3), AND (4) DO NOT APPLY TO A PERSON
- 4 REGULATED AS A DEALER UNDER FEDERAL LAW AND THAT IS ENGAGED IN
- 5 ANIMAL BLOOD BANKING. A PERSON REGULATED AS A DEALER UNDER FEDERAL
- 6 LAW AND THAT IS ENGAGED IN ANIMAL BLOOD BANKING MAY OBTAIN A CAT OR
- 7 DOG SOLELY FOR THE PURPOSE OF THE DONATION OF BLOOD.
- 8 Sec. 9. (1) Dogs and cats shall not be offered for sale or
- 9 sold A PERSON SHALL NOT SELL OR OFFER TO SELL A DOG OR CAT to a
- 10 research facility at public auction or by weight. ; or purchased by
- 11 a research facility at public auction or by weight.
- 12 (2) A research facility shall not purchase any dogs or cats
- 13 except from a licensed dealer, public dog pound, humane society, or
- 14 from AN ANIMAL CONTROL SHELTER, AN ANIMAL PROTECTION SHELTER, OR a
- 15 person who breeds or raises dogs or cats for sale. Any county,
- 16 city, village or township operating a dog pound or animal shelter
- 17 may sell for an amount not to exceed \$10.00 per animal or otherwise
- 18 dispose of unclaimed or unwanted dogs and cats to a Michigan
- 19 research facility.
- 20 Enacting section 1. Section 15 of 1969 PA 224, MCL 287.395, is
- 21 repealed.
