## SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4729

(As amended September 9, 2009)

A bill to amend 2004 PA 452, entitled "Identity theft protection act,"

(MCL 445.61 to 445.77) by adding section 14; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 14. (1) THE IDENTITY THEFT PROTECTION COMMISSION IS
- 2 ESTABLISHED IN THE DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY AND, EXCEPT
- 3 AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (10), IS 1 OF THE ADVISORY WORKGROUPS OF
- 4 THE INFORMATION PRIVACY PROTECTION COUNCIL AS AUTHORIZED UNDER
- 5 SECTION VI-E OF EXECUTIVE REORGANIZATION ORDER NO. 2009-18.
- 6 (2) THE IDENTITY THEFT COMMISSION SHALL CONSIST OF [11] MEMBERS
- 7 AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 (A) THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY
- OR HIS OR HER DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE, WHO SHALL SERVE AS
- 3 CHAIRPERSON OF THE COMMISSION.
- 4 (B) THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE OR HIS OR
- 5 HER DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE.
- 6 (C) THE COMMISSIONER OF THE OFFICE OF FINANCIAL AND INSURANCE
- 7 REGULATION OR HIS OR HER DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE.
- 8 (D) THE STATE TREASURER OR HIS OR HER DESIGNATED
- 9 REPRESENTATIVE.
- 10 (E) THREE MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC TO REPRESENT THE
- 11 INTERESTS OF CONSUMERS, 1 APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR, 1 APPOINTED BY
- 12 THE GOVERNOR FROM A LIST OF 3 OR MORE NOMINEES SUBMITTED BY THE
- 13 SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, AND 1 APPOINTED BY THE
- 14 GOVERNOR FROM A LIST OF 3 OR MORE NOMINEES SUBMITTED BY THE
- 15 MAJORITY LEADER OF THE SENATE.
- 16 (F) TWO MEMBERS OF THE BUSINESS COMMUNITY, [1 APPOINTED BY THE
- GOVERNOR FROM A LIST OF 3 OR MORE NOMINEES SUBMITTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, AND 1 APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR FROM A LIST OF 3 OR MORE NOMINEES SUBMITTED BY THE MAJORITY LEADER OF THE SENATE.
  - (G) TWO MEMBERS OF THE NONPROFIT COMMUNITY FROM ORGANIZATIONS WHOSE MISSIONS DEAL SUBSTANTIALLY WITH PROTECTING CONSUMER PRIVACY, 1 APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR FROM A LIST OF 3 OR MORE NOMINEES SUBMITTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, AND 1 APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR FROM A LIST OF 3 OR MORE NOMINEES SUBMITTED BY THE MAJORITY LEADER OF THE SENATE.]
- 18 (3) BY SEPTEMBER 30, 2011, THE IDENTITY THEFT COMMISSION SHALL
- 19 DO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 20 (A) ORGANIZE AND ADOPT STANDARDS GOVERNING THE COMMISSION'S
- 21 FORMAL AND INFORMAL PROCEDURES.
- 22 (B) KEEP A RECORD OF THE PROCEEDINGS AND ACTIVITIES OF THE
- 23 COMMISSION.
- 24 (C) REVIEW AND PROVIDE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE GOVERNOR AND TO
- 25 THE INFORMATION PRIVACY PROTECTION COUNCIL CONCERNING STATE RULES,
- 26 GUIDELINES, OR PROCEDURES RELATED TO IDENTITY THEFT PROTECTION AND
- 27 PREVENTION.

- 1 (D) REVIEW AND PROVIDE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE LEGISLATURE AND
- 2 TO THE INFORMATION PRIVACY PROTECTION COUNCIL CONCERNING
- 3 LEGISLATIVE ACTION RELATED TO IDENTITY THEFT PROTECTION AND
- 4 PREVENTION.
- 5 (E) PROVIDE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE PUBLIC AND TO THE
- 6 INFORMATION PRIVACY PROTECTION COUNCIL CONCERNING BUSINESS
- 7 PRACTICES RELATED TO IDENTITY THEFT PROTECTION AND PREVENTION.
- 8 (F) PROVIDE RECOMMENDATIONS TO STATE AGENCIES AND DEPARTMENTS
- 9 AND TO THE INFORMATION PRIVACY PROTECTION COUNCIL ON REDUCING THE
- 10 USE OF SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS BY THOSE AGENCIES OR DEPARTMENTS.
- 11 (G) ESTABLISH A PROCESS FOR RECOGNIZING PERSONS OR AGENCIES
- 12 THAT HAVE EXEMPLARY BUSINESS PRACTICES IN IDENTITY THEFT PROTECTION
- 13 AND PREVENTION.
- 14 (H) MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION
- 15 TECHNOLOGY AND TO THE INFORMATION PRIVACY PROTECTION COUNCIL
- 16 CONCERNING THE DESIGN AND CONTENT OF THE IDENTITY THEFT INFORMATION
- 17 WEBSITE DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (9).
- 18 (I) PERFORM ANY OTHER DUTIES THE COMMISSION DETERMINES ARE
- 19 APPROPRIATE RELATED TO IDENTITY THEFT PROTECTION AND PREVENTION.
- 20 (4) A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE IDENTITY THEFT COMMISSION
- 21 CONSTITUTE A QUORUM FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONDUCTING BUSINESS AND
- 22 EXERCISING THE POWERS OF THE IDENTITY THEFT COMMISSION. OFFICIAL
- 23 ACTION OF THE IDENTITY THEFT COMMISSION MAY BE TAKEN UPON A VOTE OF
- 24 A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE IDENTITY THEFT COMMISSION.
- 25 (5) THE IDENTITY THEFT COMMISSION MAY ADOPT, AMEND, AND
- 26 RESCIND BYLAWS, RULES, AND REGULATIONS FOR THE CONDUCT OF ITS
- 27 BUSINESS.

- 1 (6) MEMBERS OF THE IDENTITY THEFT COMMISSION SHALL SERVE
- 2 WITHOUT COMPENSATION, BUT ARE ENTITLED TO ACTUAL AND NECESSARY
- 3 EXPENSES INCURRED IN THE PERFORMANCE OF OFFICIAL DUTIES UNDER THIS
- 4 SECTION.
- 5 (7) THE COMMISSION SHALL CONDUCT ITS BUSINESS AT PUBLIC
- 6 MEETINGS HELD IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE OPEN MEETINGS ACT, 1976 PA
- 7 267, MCL 15.261 TO 15.275. A WRITING PREPARED, OWNED, USED, IN THE
- 8 POSSESSION OF, OR RETAINED BY THE COMMISSION IN THE PERFORMANCE OF
- 9 AN OFFICIAL FUNCTION SHALL BE AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC IN COMPLIANCE
- 10 WITH THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT, 1976 PA 442, MCL 15.231 TO
- 11 15.246.
- 12 (8) THE DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SHALL PROVIDE
- 13 STAFF ASSISTANCE TO THE IDENTITY THEFT COMMISSION AS NECESSARY TO
- 14 CARRY OUT THE COMMISSION'S DUTIES UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 15 (9) THE DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SHALL ESTABLISH
- 16 AND MAINTAIN AN IDENTITY THEFT INFORMATION WEBSITE. THE DEPARTMENT
- 17 OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SHALL CONSIDER THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE
- 18 IDENTITY THEFT COMMISSION IN SELECTING THE DESIGN AND CONTENT OF
- 19 THE WEBSITE.
- 20 (10) IF THE INFORMATION PRIVACY PROTECTION COUNCIL CREATED
- 21 UNDER SECTION VI OF EXECUTIVE REORGANIZATION ORDER NO. 2009-18 IS
- 22 NOT FULLY OPERATIONAL WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF
- 23 THIS ACT, THE IDENTITY THEFT PROTECTION COMMISSION CREATED IN
- 24 SUBSECTION (1) SHALL NOT BE 1 OF THE ADVISORY WORKGROUPS OF THE
- 25 INFORMATION PROTECTION PRIVACY COUNCIL BUT SHALL INSTEAD EXIST AS A
- 26 SEPARATE COMMISSION WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION
- 27 TECHNOLOGY. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE INFORMATION

- 1 PRIVACY PROTECTION COUNCIL IS FULLY OPERATIONAL WHEN ALL OF ITS
- 2 MEMBERS HAVE BEEN APPOINTED, AND AT LEAST 1 MEETING OF THE COUNCIL
- 3 HAS BEEN HELD. IF THE IDENTITY THEFT PROTECTION COMMISSION DOES
- 4 BECOME 1 OF THE ADVISORY WORKGROUPS OF THE INFORMATION PROTECTION
- 5 SECURITY COUNCIL, BUT THE INFORMATION PROTECTION SECURITY COUNCIL
- 6 SUBSEQUENTLY IS ABOLISHED BY LAW OR EXECUTIVE ORDER, THE IDENTITY
- 7 THEFT PROTECTION COMMISSION SHALL CONTINUE ITS EXISTENCE AS A
- 8 SEPARATE COMMISSION WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION
- 9 TECHNOLOGY.
- 10 Enacting section 1. Section 14 of the identity theft
- 11 protection act, 2004 PA 452, MCL 445.74, is repealed effective
- 12 December 31, 2011.
- 13 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 14 unless all of the following bills of the 95th Legislature are
- 15 enacted into law:
